

## Jubilee Quilt 1

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt 62" x 62 " - unfinished block size

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Jubilee collection

1. A344.1-Royal Britannia on cream - $1^{1 / 2} \mathrm{yd}$ - 1 1/2mtr
2. A610.2- Jubilee on light blue - 1yd - 1 mtr 3. A612.3-Union jacks on dark blue - 3/8yd 40 cm
3. A611.2 - Metallic silver crown on red $5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
4. A345.4-Union jack hearts on royal blue $1 \mathrm{yd}-1 \mathrm{mtr}$
5. BB184-Post box red $-3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-3 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$

Wadding and backing 66" x 66"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## Making up the blocks

All the blocks are made up in the same way. Lay out your fabric pieces for the centre of the block as in diagram 1. Stitch the two small triangles to each side of the large triangle. Do this to all four triangles.
Now lay out your stitch pieces. Sewing in rows and then stitch the rows together to complete the centre part of the block.
Next part of the block. Lay out your fabric pieces for each corner. Sewing the two small squares together and then sew them to your strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ as in the block diagram 2 for each corner. Stitch a triangle to each side of the squares on two of them and then sew them to the centre part of the block as in the diagram 3.
Do the same to the other two corners but this time add another triangle to each side. Now sew them to each side of the block.
You need 9 blocks in total.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
$9 \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
$36 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$36 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
From fabric 2 cut
$18 \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
From fabric 3 cut
$9 \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
$36 \times 25 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 25 / \mathbf{8}^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 4 cut

$9 \times 43 / 4 " \times 4^{3 / 4 "}$
$18 \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$ " cut in half diagonally twice
From fabric 5 cut
$24 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - sashing
From fabric 6 cut
$36 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$16 \times 2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Completing the quilt

Place all the blocks, sashing and squares out as in the main diagram.
Starting with a square and then sashing for the first row. The next row will be a square and block row.
Repeat down the rows as in the main diagram to complete the quilt.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.

## Jubilee Quilt 2

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt $62^{\prime \prime} \times 62^{\prime \prime}$ - unfinished block size $18^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Jubilee collection

1. A344.2-Royal Britannia on blue - $1^{11 / 2 y d}-$ $11 / 2 \mathrm{mtr}$
2. A610.1-Jubilee on dark cream - 1yd 1 mtr
3. A612.2 - Union jacks on light blue - 3/8yd 40 cm
4. A611.1 - Metallic gold crown on cream 5/8yd - 70 cm
5. A345.3-Union jack hearts on black-1yd - 1 mtr
6. BB111 - Indigo - $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-3 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$

Wadding and backing $66^{\prime \prime} \times 66$ "

All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## Making up the blocks

From fabric 1 cut
$9 \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 71^{\prime \prime}$ " cut in half diagonally twice
$36 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$36 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
From fabric 2 cut
$18 \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
From fabric 3 cut
$9 \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
$36 \times 25 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 25 / \mathbf{8}^{\prime \prime}$
From fabric 4 cut
$9 \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
$18 \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
From fabric 5 cut
$24 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{1 / 2 "}$ - sashing
From fabric 6 cut
$36 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$16 \times 2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt 62" x 62" - unfinished block size $18^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Jubilee collection

1. A344.3-Royal Britannia on grey - $1^{1 / 2}$ yd $11 / 2 \mathrm{mtr}$
2. A610.3-Jubilee on royal blue - 1yd 1 mtr
3. A612.1 - Union jacks on cream - 3/8yd 40 cm
4. A611.3-Metallic gold crown on dark blue $-5 / 8 y d-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
5. A345.1- Union jack hearts on cream $1 \mathrm{yd}-1 \mathrm{mtr}$
6. BB286-Eggshell blue $-3 / 4 y d-3 / 4 m t r$

Wadding and backing 66" x 66"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

$36 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 2 cut

$18 \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
From fabric 3 cut
$9 \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
$36 \times 25 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 25 / \mathbf{8}^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 4 cut

$9 \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
$18 \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
From fabric 5 cut
$24 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{1 / 2 "}$ - sashing
From fabric 6 cut
$36 \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$16 \times 2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
