



Spring Treats Quilt 1

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt 60" x 60" - unfinished block size 10" x 10"

Requirements

Fabrics from Spring Treats collection A591.1 Mirrored bun-1. & chicks on cream - 3/8vd 40cm ny 2. A589.2 - Mini heart floral yellow - fat¹/₄ A591.3 Mirrored 3. bun-& chicks on rose pink - 5/8yd -60cm ny A589.1 flo-4. Mini heart 3/8**vd** 40cm pink ral on cream A590.2 Chicks bun-5. & nies on light blue 1/2yd ¹/₂mtr 6. A592.1 - Spring floral on cream - 3/8yd - 40cm 7. A590.1 - Chicks & bunnies on cream - fat¹/₄ 8. A592.2 - Spring floral on green - 3/8yd - 40cm 9. A588.1 **Spring** gnomes cream 5/8**yd** 60cm on 10. A588.3 **Spring** gnomes 3/4mtr on dark blue 3/4**vd** 11. BB40 Cream 5/8**yd** 60cm 12. BB286 - Eggshell blue - 3/4yd - 3/4mtr Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

(You will need to join your strips to get the length on the borders)

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut - block 1

 $5 \times 5^{7/8}$ " x $5^{7/8}$ " cut diagonally once (from bottom left to top right)

 $5 \times 5^{7/8}$ " x $5^{7/8}$ " cut diagonally once (from top left to bottom right)

From fabric 2 cut - block 1

5 x 61/4" x 61/4" cut diagonally twice

From fabric 3 cut - block 2

 $8 \times 5^{7/8}$ " x $5^{7/8}$ " cut diagonally once (from bottom left to top right)

 $8 \times 5^{7/8}$ " x $5^{7/8}$ " cut diagonally once (from top left to bottom right)

From fabric 4 cut - block 2

8 x 6¹/₄" x 6¹/₄" cut diagonally twice

From fabric 5 cut

32 x 2½" x 6½" block 3

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 4³/₄" x 4³/₄" block 3

32 x 2½" x 2½" block 3

From fabric 7 cut

16 x 21/2" x 61/2" block 4

From fabric 8 cut

4 x 4³/₄" x 4³/₄" block 4

16 x 2½" x 2½" block 4

From fabric 9 cut

2 x 2½" x 52½" middle border for sides

 $2 \times 2^{1/2}$ " x $56^{1/2}$ " middle border top & bottom

From fabric 10 cut

2 x 2½" x 56½" outer border sides

2 x 21/2" x 601/2" outer border top & bottom

From fabric 11 cut

13 x 6¹/₄" x 6¹/₄" cut diagonally twice for blocks 1 & 2

From fabric 12 cut

24 x 3% x 3% cut diagonally once for blocks 3

& 4

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border for sides

2 x 1½" x 52½" inner border top & bottom

Making up the blocks

This is made up of four blocks, but only two patterns. Block 1 and 2 are the same. As is block 3 and 4 the same pattern.

Block 1 & 2

Lay out the fabric piece as in block 1. Start by sewing the small triangles together to make a larger triangle. Now stitch the two triangles together as in block 1 to make a square. Do the same to the other triangles. Now sew the two top squares together and then do the same to the bottom two. Join the two halves' together to complete the block. For block 1 you will need 5 in total and for block 2 you need to sew 8 blocks in total.

Block 3 & 4

Place out the fabric pieces for block 3 as in the diagram. Start with sewing the small triangles to the center square. Opposite sides first press back and then the other two triangles to the square.

Stitch the two side strips to the block. Next stitch a square to each end of the other two strips. Sew them to the top and bottom of the block.

In total 8 of block 3 and 4 of block 4.

Making up the quilt center.

Lay out all your blocks as in the main diagram.

Stitch in row pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. As this will help with sewing the rows together.

Borders - You have three borders on this guilt.

Inner border: stitch the sides and then the top and bottom to the quilt center.

Middle border: sew the sides and then the top and bottom

Outer border: the same as the other two borders.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 10 to bind the quilt.



Chicks & 1/2**mtr** nies on cream 1/2yd 6. A592.3 Spring floviolet 3/8**vd** 40cm ral on dark 7. A590.3 - Chicks & bunnies on yellow - fat¹/₄ 8. A592.1 - Spring floral on cream - 3/8yd - 40cm 9. All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut - block 1

5 x 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈" cut diagonally once (from bottom left to top right)

5 x 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈" cut diagonally once (from top left to bottom right)

From fabric 2 cut - block 1

5 x 6¹/₄" x 6¹/₄" cut diagonally twice

From fabric 3 cut - block 2

8 x 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈" cut diagonally once (from bottom left to top right)

8 x 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈" cut diagonally once (from top left to bottom right)

From fabric 4 cut - block 2

8 x 6¹/₄" x 6¹/₄" cut diagonally twice

From fabric 5 cut

32 x 2½" x 6½" block 3

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 4³/₄" x 4³/₄" block 3

32 x 2½" x 2½" block 3

From fabric 7 cut

16 x 21/2" x 61/2" block 4

From fabric 8 cut

4 x 4³/₄" x 4³/₄" block 4

From fabric 9 cut

2 x 2½" x 52½" middle border for sides

2 x 2½" x 56½" middle border top & bottom

From fabric 10 cut

2 x 21/2" x 561/2" outer border sides

2 x 2½" x 60½" outer border top & bottom

From fabric 11 cut

13 x 6¹/₄" x 6¹/₄" cut diagonally twice for blocks

1 & 2

From fabric 12 cut

24 x 3⁷/₈" x 3⁷/₈" cut diagonally once for blocks 3

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border for sides

2 x 1½" x 52½" inner border top & bottom

Making up the blocks

This is made up of four blocks, but only two patterns. Block 1 and 2 are the same. As is block 3 and 4 the same pattern.

Block 1 & 2

Lay out the fabric piece as in block 1. Start by sewing the small triangles together to make a larger triangle. Now stitch the two triangles together as in block 1 to make a square. Do the same to the other triangles. Now sew the two top squares together and then do the same to the bottom two. Join the two halves' together to complete the block. For block 1 you will need 5 in total and for block 2 you need to sew 8 blocks in total.

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Outer border: the same as the other two borders.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 10 to bind the quilt.


