



## Spring Treats Quilt 1

Designed and made by Sally Ablett

Size of quilt 60" x 60" - unfinished block size

10" x 10"

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Spring Treats collection	16 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " block 4
1. A591.1 - Mirrored bunny & chicks on cream - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 40cm	From fabric 9 cut
2. A589.2 - Mini heart floral yellow - fat <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub>	2 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 52 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " middle border for sides
3. A591.3 - Mirrored bunny & chicks on rose pink - <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 60cm	2 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 56 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " middle border top & bottom
4. A589.1 - Mini heart floral pink on cream - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 40cm	From fabric 10 cut
5. A590.2 - Chicks & bunnies on light blue - <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> yd - <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> mtr	2 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 56 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " outer border sides
6. A592.1 - Spring floral on cream - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 40cm	2 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 60 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " outer border top & bottom
7. A590.1 - Chicks & bunnies on cream - fat <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub>	From fabric 11 cut
8. A592.2 - Spring floral on green - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 40cm	13 x 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " cut diagonally twice for blocks 1 & 2
9. A588.1 - Spring gnomes on cream - <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 60cm	From fabric 12 cut
10. A588.3 - Spring gnomes on dark blue - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yd - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> mtr	24 x 3 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 3 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " cut diagonally once for blocks 3 & 4
11. BB40 - Cream - <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 60cm	2 x 1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 50 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " inner border for sides
12. BB286 - Eggshell blue - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yd - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> mtr	2 x 1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 52 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " inner border top & bottom

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

All measurements include <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

(You will need to join your strips to get the length on the borders)

## Making up the blocks

This is made up of four blocks, but only two patterns. Block 1 and 2 are the same. As is block 3 and 4 the same pattern.

### Block 1 & 2

Lay out the fabric piece as in block 1. Start by sewing the small triangles together to make a larger triangle. Now stitch the two triangles together as in block 1 to make a square. Do the same to the other triangles. Now sew the two top squares together and then do the same to the bottom two. Join the two halves' together to complete the block. For block 1 you will need 5 in total and for block 2 you need to sew 8 blocks in total.

### Block 3 & 4

Place out the fabric pieces for block 3 as in the diagram. Start with sewing the small triangles to the center square. Opposite sides first press back and then the other two triangles to the square.

Stitch the two side strips to the block. Next stitch a square to each end of the other two strips. Sew them to the top and bottom of the block.

In total 8 of block 3 and 4 of block 4.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut - block 1

5 x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" cut diagonally once (from bottom left to top right)

5 x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" cut diagonally once (from top left to bottom right)

From fabric 2 cut - block 1

5 x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" cut diagonally twice

From fabric 3 cut - block 2

8 x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" cut diagonally once (from bottom left to top right)

8 x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" cut diagonally once (from top left to bottom right)

From fabric 4 cut - block 2

8 x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" cut diagonally twice

From fabric 5 cut

32 x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" block 3

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" block 3

32 x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" block 3

From fabric 7 cut

16 x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" block 4

From fabric 8 cut

4 x 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" block 4

### Making up the quilt center.

Lay out all your blocks as in the main diagram.

Stitch in row pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. As this will help with sewing the rows together.

**Borders** - You have three borders on this quilt.

**Inner border:** stitch the sides and then the top and bottom to the quilt center.

**Middle border:** sew the sides and then the top and bottom

**Outer border:** the same as the other two borders.

### Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

### Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 10 to bind the quilt.

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Size of quilt 60" x 60" - unfinished block size

10" x 10"

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Spring Treats collection	16 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " block 4
1. A591.2 - Mirrored bunny & chicks on duck egg - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 40cm	From fabric 9 cut
2. A589.3 - Mini heart floral blue - fat <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub>	2 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 52 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " middle border for sides
3. A591.1 - Mirrored bunny & chicks on cream - <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 60cm	2 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 56 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " middle border top & bottom
4. A589.1 - Mini heart floral pink on cream - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 40cm	From fabric 10 cut
5. A590.1 - Chicks & bunnies on cream - <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> yd <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> mtr	2 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 56 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " outer border sides
6. A592.3 - Spring floral on dark violet - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 40cm	2 x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 60 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " outer border top & bottom
7. A590.3 - Chicks & bunnies on yellow - fat <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub>	From fabric 11 cut
8. A592.1 - Spring floral on cream - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 40cm	13 x 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " cut diagonally twice for blocks 1 & 2
9. A588.2 - Spring gnomes on dark lavender - <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 60cm	From fabric 12 cut
10. A588.1 - Spring gnomes on cream - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yd - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> mtr	24 x 3 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 3 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " cut diagonally once for blocks 3 & 4
11. BB286 - Eggshell blue - <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yd - 60cm	2 x 1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 50 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " inner border for sides
12. BB284 - Cottage rose - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yd - <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> mtr	2 x 1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 52 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " inner border top & bottom

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From fabric 2 cut - block 1

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From fabric 3 cut - block 2

8 x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 5<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" cut diagonally once (from bottom left to top right)

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From fabric 4 cut - block 2

8 x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" cut diagonally twice

From fabric 5 cut

32 x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" block 3

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" block 3

32 x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" block 3

From fabric 7 cut

16 x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" block 4

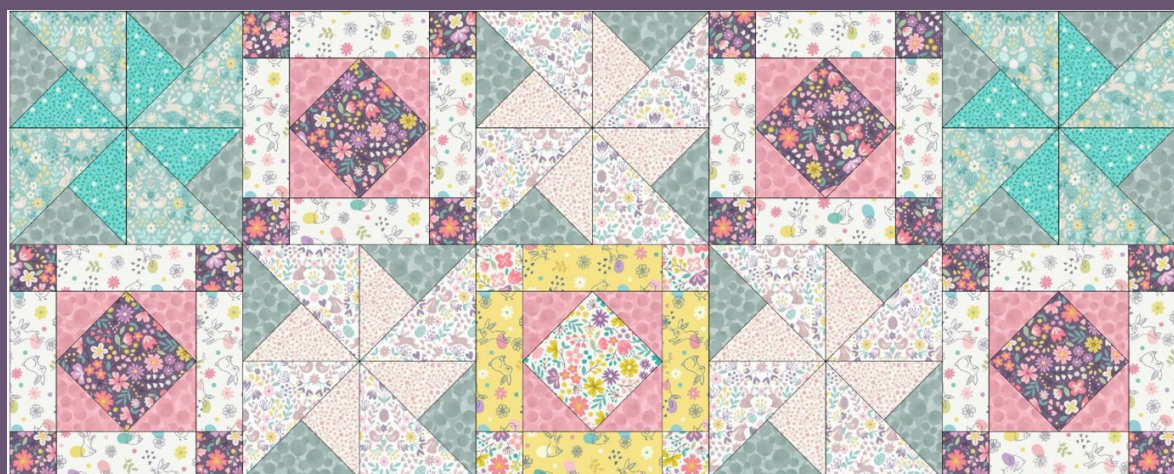
