## Fabrics from Cast a Spell collection

1. A719.1 - Cast a spell on cream - fat $1 / 4$
2. A720.2 - Purple floral bat - fat $1 / 4$
3. A721.2-Green Halloween bottles - fat $1 / 4$
4. A722.3-Flying witches on grey - fat $1 / 4$
5. A723.2 - Spooky Halloween on green - fat $1 / 4$
6. A719.2 - Cast a spell on purple -fat $1 / 4$
7. A720.1- Orange floral bat - fat $1 / 4$
8. A721.1-Grey Halloween bottles -fat $1 / 4$
9. A722.2 - Flying witches on purple - fat $1 / 4$
10. A723.2 - Spooky Halloween on green - fat $t^{1 / 4}$
11. BB94-Light grey $-1 / 2 y d-1 / 2 m$
12. BB345-Halloween Orange $-5 / 8 y d-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
13. B20-Black - 1yd - 1 m

Wadding and backing 46" x 60"
All measurements include $1 / 4^{"}$ seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

## Cutting

From each of the fabrics $1,3,5,7,8,9$ and 10 you need to cut
$1 \times 61 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2{ }^{1}$ for pumpkin block
$2 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 61 / 2{ }^{1} \mathrm{~W}$ W for cat blocks
$2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ for cat blocks
$4 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ for cat blocks
From each of the fabric 2, 4 and 6 you need to cut
$2 \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ " for pumpkin block
$1 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 61 / 2{ }^{1} \mathrm{~W}$ W for cat blocks
$1 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ for cat blocks
$2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ for cat blocks
From fabric 11 cut
$16 \times 31 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2{ }^{2}$ for cat top right side $16 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \times 1 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ for cat top of head


Lay out the fabric pieces for cat block. On the back of fabric 1 and 11 draw a diagonally line. 2 of fabric 1 and 1 of fabric 11. Sew and trim away the outer edge. From the sew line


Do the same on the cat's body.
Do the same to the body. Sew the top row together and then stitch to the body. You need 16 in total looking at the colour way for each cat.



Pumpkin block. On the back of fabric 11 draw a diagonally line as before and sew in the same way. Lay out fabric pieces as in block diagram and sew the top strip together and then sew to the pumpkin body. You need 14 in total looking at the colour way for each cat.

## Sashing

Take the squares of fabrics 12 and 13. Draw a diagonally line on one of the squares. Stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ each side of the pencil line. Cut on the pencil line, press. Trim back to a $21 / 4$ " square.

Lay out all the sashing strips, squares and blocks as in the maim diagram. Sew in rows and then stitch the rows together to complete the Wall hanging.


Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 12 to bind the quilt.
You could make some table mats to match your runner

Wadding and backing 46" x 60"
All measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

## Cutting

From each of the fabrics $1,3,5,7,8,9$ and 10 you need to cut
$1 \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ " for pumpkin block
$2 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ for cat blocks
$2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ for cat blocks
$4 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ for cat blocks
From each of the fabric 2, 4 and 6 you need to cut
$2 \times 61 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2$ " for pumpkin block
$1 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ W for cat blocks
$1 \times 21 / 2 " \mathrm{H} \times 31 / 22^{2} \mathrm{~W}$ for cat blocks
$2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ for cat blocks

## From fabric 11 cut

$16 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 31 / 2{ }^{2}$ for cat top right side
$16 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ for cat top of head

$16 \times 2$ " $\times 2$ " for cat<br>$28 \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ for pumpkin<br>$56 \times 2$ " x 2" for pumpkin

## From fabric 12 cut

$30 \times 2 \frac{1}{4} 1 \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$30 \times 23 / 4$ " $23 / 4 "$

## From fabric 13 cut

$1 \times 21 / 4$ " $543 / 4$ " left side border
$1 \times 21 / 4 " \times 42^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ bottom border
$30 \times 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$30 \times 23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$


Cat block


Lay out the fabric pieces for cat block. On the back of fabric 1 and 11 draw a diagonally line. 2 of fabric 1 and 1 of fabric 11. Sew and trim away the outer edge. From the sew line


Do the same on the cat's body.
Do the same to the body. Sew the top row together and then stitch to the body. You need 16 in total looking at the colour way for each cat.



Pumpkin block. On the back of fabric 11 draw a diagonally line as before and sew in the same way. Lay out fabric pieces as in block diagram and sew the top strip together and then sew to the pumpkin body. You need 14 in total looking at the colour way for each cat.

## Sashing

Take the squares of fabrics 12 and 13. Draw a diagonally line on one of the squares. Stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ each side of the pencil line. Cut on the pencil line, press. Trim back to a $21 / 4$ " square.

Lay out all the sashing strips, squares and blocks as in the maim diagram. Sew in rows and then stitch the rows together to complete the Wall hanging.
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Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 12 to bind the quilt.
