# Requirements

#### Fabrics from the Secret Garden collection

- 1. A704.1 The secret garden on duck green long 1/4
- 2. A705.2 Daisies on muted lilac long 1/4
- 3. A706.3 Roses on sage long 1/4
- 4. A707.3 Hydrangea pink ½yd
- 5. A708.2 Robin floral on light beige long 1/4
- 6. A704.3 The secret garden on muted lilac long 1/4
- 7. A705.1 Daisies on duck egg long 1/4
- 8. A706.2 Roses on muted rose long 1/4
- 9. A707.1 Hydrangea light neutral ½yd
- 10. A708.3 Robin floral on muted sage long 1/4
- 11. BB331 Light Beige 2yd 2m
- 12. BB340 Cornflower 11/4yd 1.20m

Wadding and backing 68" x 68"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

# Cutting

From fabric 2 cut - From fabric 7 cut

48 x 2½" x 2½" - 48 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 3 cut - From fabric 8 cut

48 x 2½" x 2½" - 48 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 4 cut - From fabric 9 cut

96 x 2½" x 2½" - 96 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 5 cut - From fabric 10 cut

12 x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - 12 x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

#### From fabric 11 cut

100 x 4½" x 4½" 24 x 2½" x 4½" 36 x 2½" x 2½"

#### From fabric 12 cut


6 x 2½" x WOF 32 x 2½" x 4½" 32 x 2½" x 2½" 16 x 2½" x 8½" out 45% angle

16 x 2½" x 8½" cut 45° angle from left and right corners \*\*\*

### **Blocks**




Block 1



Block 2

Draw a diagonally line on the back of fabrics 4,9, 11 and 12.





Place a small square onto the lager

square. Stitch on the outer edge of the pencil line. Trim away a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the out edge of the stitch line. Do the same to the other side. Look at the main diagram for the placement of fabric in each block.

Block 2 - Lay out the fabric pieces for each block as in the main diagram. Sew the small squares together and then stitch in rows to complete the block.

# Complete the quilt

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows, pressing your seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing the rows together.



The first 3 Rows of the quilt center. Look at the placement for each of the blocks in the quilt as you sew the rows.

### Border


#### Inner border



Draw a diagonally line on the back of fabrics 11.

As before pace a small square onto the strip. Stitch on the outer edge of the pencil line. Trim away a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the out edge of the stitch line. Do the same to the other side. Look at the main diagram for the placement of fabric in each block. You need 16 in total.

#### Next block







Draw a diagonally line on the back of fabrics 4. Same as before with the squares. Join the two strips together to complete the block.

You need 8 of block A and 4 of block B.

Lay out the inner border as in the main diagram and sew the strips together 7 for the sides. Add to the quilt. On the top and bottom strip add a square to each end and sew to the quilt.

#### **Outer border**

You need to join your strip to get the length for your border.

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $60\frac{1}{2}$ " Stitch to the sides of the quilt.

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.



Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.



Use your favorite method from fabric 12 to bind the quilt.

- 6. A704.1 The secret garden on duck green long 1/4

- 9. A707.3 Hydrangea pink ½yd
- 10. A708.2 Robin floral on light beige long 1/4
- 11. BB40 Cream 2yd 2m
- 12. BB331 Light Beige 11/4yd 1.20m

Wadding and backing 68" x 68"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

# Cutting

From fabric 1 cut - From fabric 6 cut

12 x 4½" x 4½" - 12 x 4½" x 4½"

From fabric 2 cut - From fabric 7 cut

48 x 2½" x 2½" - 48 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 3 cut - From fabric 8 cut

48 x 2½" x 2½" - 48 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 4 cut - From fabric 9 cut

96 x 2½" x 2½" - 96 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 5 cut - From fabric 10 cut

 $12 \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " -  $12 \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

#### From fabric 11 cut

100 x 4½" x 4½" 24 x 2½" x 4½" 36 x 2½" x 2½"

#### From fabric 12 cut

6 x 2½" x WOF 32 x 2½" x 4½" 32 x 2½" x 2½"

16 x 2½" x 8½" cut 45° angle from left and right corners \*\*\*

### **Blocks**







Block 2

Draw a diagonally line on the back of fabrics 4,9, 11 and 12.





Place a small square onto the lager

square. Stitch on the outer edge of the pencil line. Trim away a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the out edge of the stitch line. Do the same to the other side. Look at the main diagram for the placement of fabric in each block.

Block 2 - Lay out the fabric pieces for each block as in the main diagram. Sew the small squares together and then stitch in rows to complete the block.

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The first 3 Rows of the quilt center. Look at the placement for each of the blocks in the quilt as you sew the rows.

### Border


#### Inner border



Draw a diagonally line on the back of fabrics 11.

As before pace a small square onto the strip. Stitch on the outer edge of the pencil line. Trim away a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the out edge of the stitch line. Do the same to the other side. Look at the main diagram for the placement of fabric in each block. You need 16 in total.

#### Next block







Draw a diagonally line on the back of fabrics 4. Same as before with the squares. Join the two strips together to complete the block.

You need 8 of block A and 4 of block B.

Lay out the inner border as in the main diagram and sew the strips together 7 for the sides. Add to the quilt. On the top and bottom strip add a square to each end and sew to the quilt.

#### **Outer border**

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 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.



Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.



Use your favorite method from fabric 12 to bind the quilt.



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
