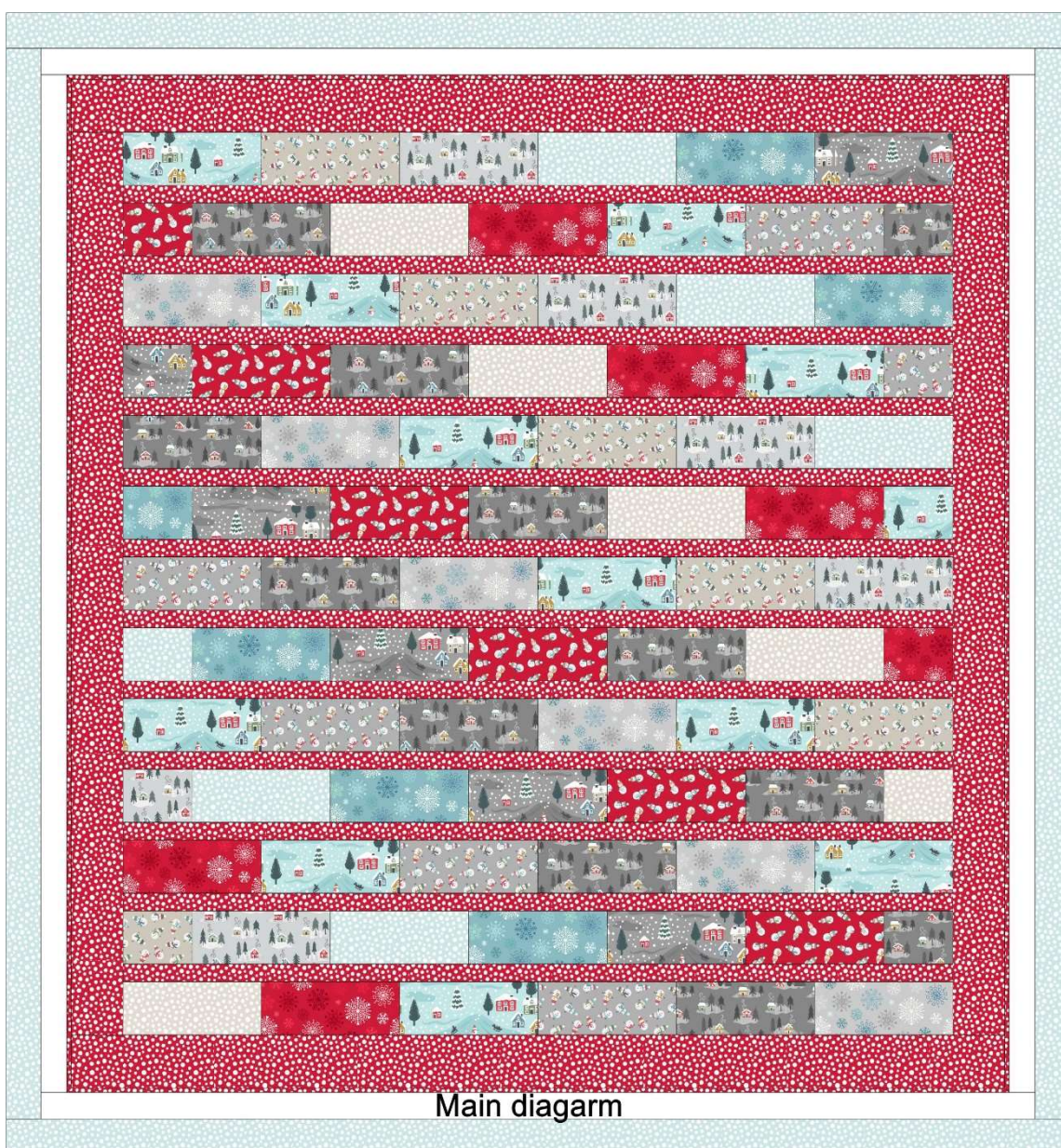

Size of quilt 54" x 57" - unfinished strips size 3½" x 8½" and 3½" x 4½"





Requirements

Fabrics from the Snow Day flannel collection.

1. F34.1 - Snow Day on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
2. F34.2 - Snow Day on icy blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. F34.3 - Snow Day on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. F35.1 - Scattered snowmen on dark cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. F35.2 - Scattered snowmen on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. F35.3 - Scattered snowmen on red - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. F36.1 - Snow Day houses on silver - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. F36.2 - Snow Day houses on icy blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. F36.3 - Snow Day houses on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. F38.1 - Snow fall on icy blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. F38.2 - Snow fall on dark cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
12. F38.3 - Snow fall on red 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yds
13. F72.1 - Snowflakes on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
14. F72.2 - Snowflakes on ice blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
15. F72.3 - Snowflakes on red - fat $\frac{1}{4}$

Wadding and backing 58" x 61"

Cutting

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the sashing and border strips.

From each of the fabrics 2 and 13 you need to cut

6 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 1, 3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,14 and 15 you need to cut

5 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

1 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 12 cut

12 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top and bottom



Making up the quilt

Lay out the fabrics for the quilt as in the main diagram with the sashing in between.



This is the top of the quilt. Sew the strips together to complete the row.

Stitch all the strips together and then sew each row together to complete the quilt center.

Border : sew the sides to the quilt, press back then the top and bottom.

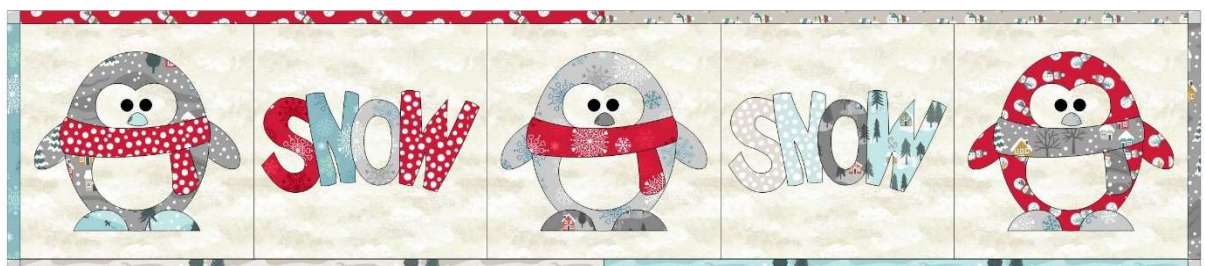
Quilting and binding

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired or maybe you could do some dogs and cats in the quilting.

Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

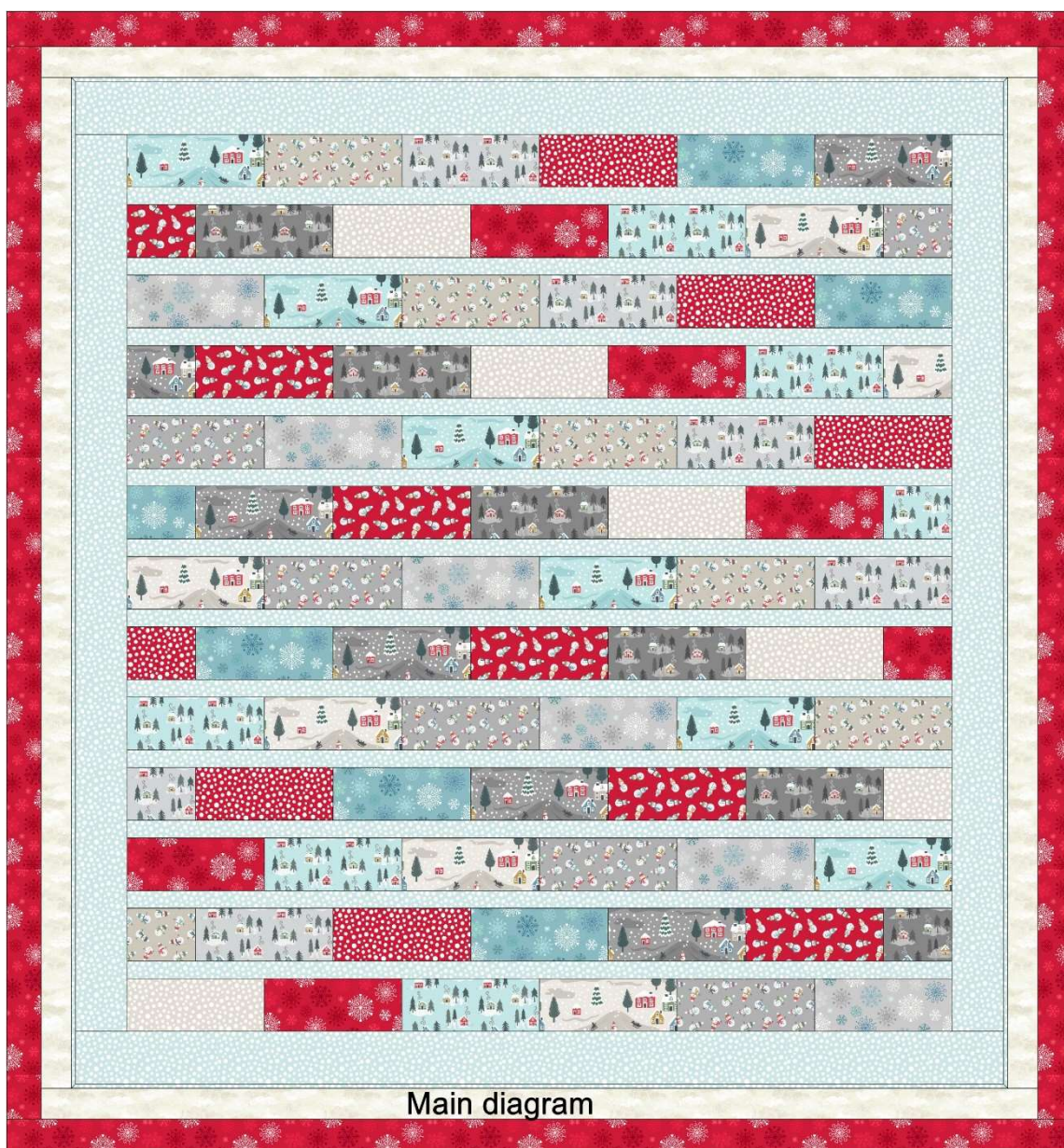
Use your favourite method from fabric 12 to bind the quilt.

1. F34.1 - Snow Day on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
2. F34.2 - Snow Day on icy blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. F34.3 - Snow Day on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. F35.1 - Scattered snowmen on dark cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. F35.2 - Scattered snowmen on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. F35.3 - Scattered snowmen on red - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. F36.1 - Snow Day houses on silver - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. F36.2 - Snow Day houses on icy blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. F36.3 - Snow Day houses on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. F38.1 - Snow fall on icy blue 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yds
11. F38.2 - Snow fall on dark cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
12. F38.3 - Snow fall on red - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
13. F72.1 - Snowflakes on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
14. F72.2 - Snowflakes on ice blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
15. F72.3 - Snowflakes on red - fat $\frac{1}{4}$

Wadding and backing 58" x 61"

Cutting

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the sashing and border strips.

From each of the fabrics 2 and 13 you need to cut

6 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 1, 3,4,5,6,7,8,9,11,12,14 and 15 you need to cut

5 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

1 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 10 cut

12 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top and bottom



Making up the quilt

Lay out the fabrics for the quilt as in the main diagram with the sashing in between.



This is the top of the quilt. Sew the strips together to complete the row.

Stitch all the strips together and then sew each row together to complete the quilt center.

Border : sew the sides to the quilt, press back then the top and bottom.

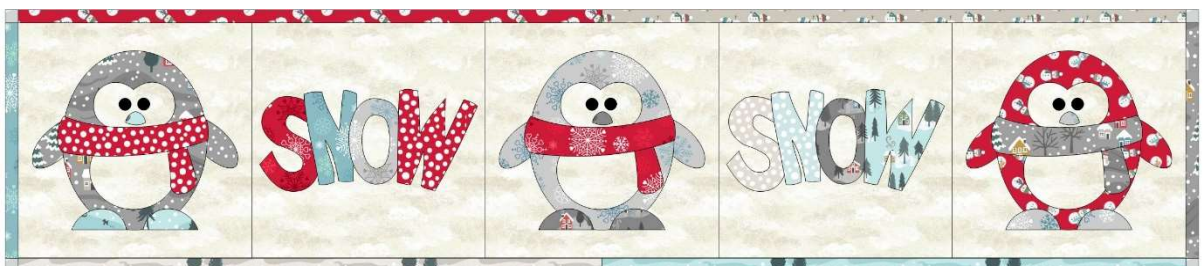
Quilting and binding

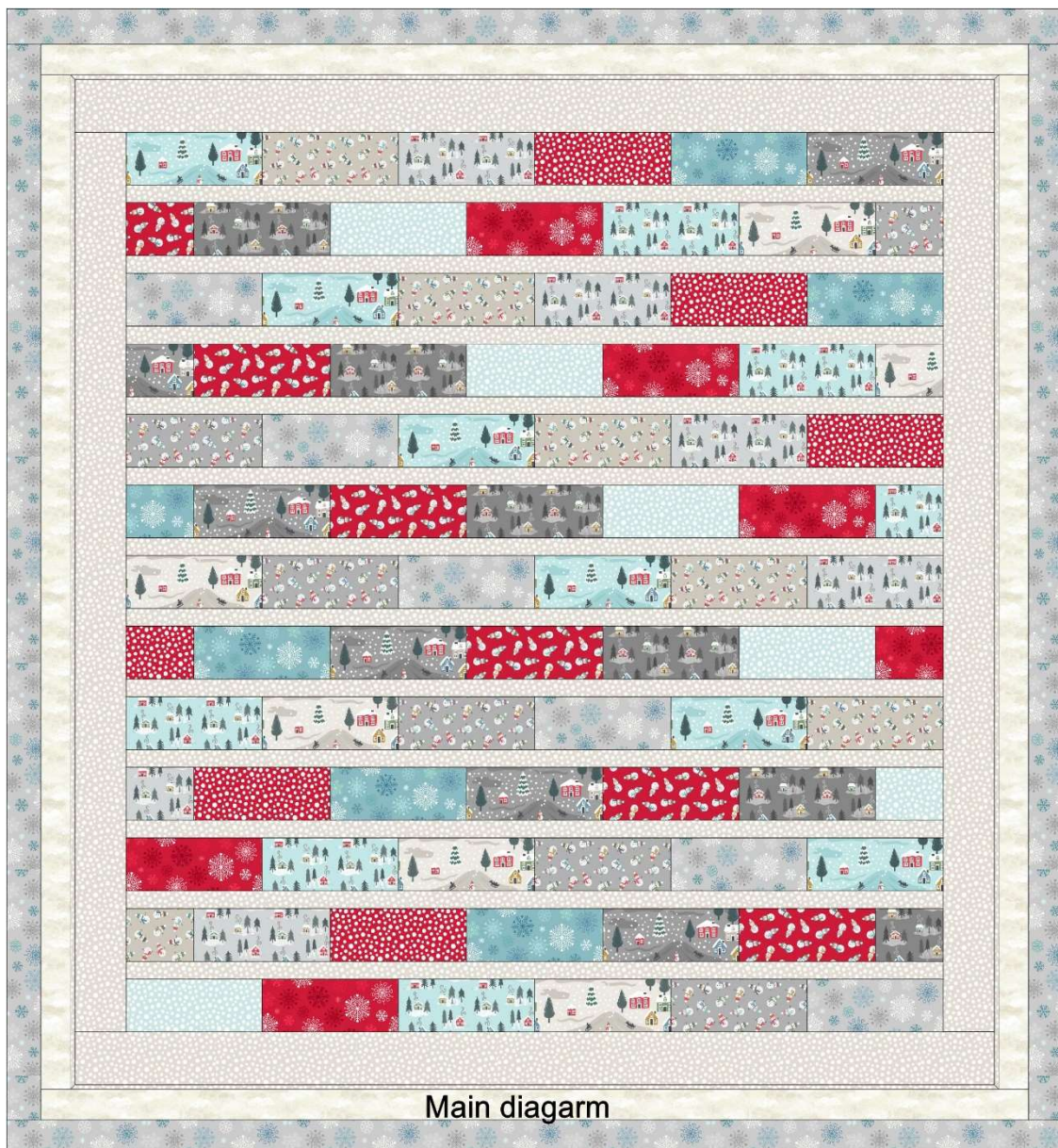

Wadding and backing 58" x 61"

Cutting

From fabric 11 cut

12 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top and bottom



Making up the quilt
