- 4. A789.1 A789.3 Red seed heads with pearl fat  $\frac{1}{4}$
- 5. A784.3 Holly and ivy on natural with pearl fat 1/4
- 6. A786.2 Winter botanical on green with pearl fat 1/4
- 7. A787.3 Snowberry on dark red with pearl fat 1/4
- 8. A789.1 Silver seed heads with pearl fat 1/4
- 9. A785.2 Pearl dots on silver 5/8 yd 60cm
- 10. A785.3 Pearl dots on winter green 5/4 yd 60cm
- 11. BB23 Post-box red 1/2 yd 1/2 m

Wadding and backing 56" x 56"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.



## From each of the fabrics 1 to 4 you need to cut

13 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once

13 x 2½" x 2½"

## From each of the fabrics 5 to 8 you need to cut

12 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once

12 x 2½" x 2½"

# From each of the fabrics 9 and 10 you need to cut

30 x 2½" x 8½"

From fabric 11 cut

36 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 12 cut

25 x  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice 80 x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

# Making up the blocks





Block 1 Block 2

Both blocks are made in the same way. Lay out the fabrics for block 1. Start with the flying geese block. Sew one small triangle to the lager triangle, press back and then do the same to the other side.



make all four the same way.


Stitch the squares together top two and then the bottom set and then



sew together Now stitch in rows and the sew the rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need 13 in total and block 2 you will sew 12 in total.

# Complete the quilt

Lay out the squares, sashing and blocks as in the main diagram.



Five rows of the quilt. Start with square and sashing row. Pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. This will help when sewing the rows together.



Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method from fabric 11 to bind the quilt.

- 12. BB01 White 11/4 1.20m

Wadding and backing 56" x 56"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.



## From each of the fabrics 1 to 4 you need to cut

13 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once

13 x 2½" x 2½"

## From each of the fabrics 5 to 8 you need to cut

12 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once

12 x 2½" x 2½"

## From each of the fabrics 9 and 10 you need to cut

30 x 2½" x 8½"

## From fabric 11 cut

36 x 2½" x 2½"



### From fabric 12 cut

25 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice

80 x 2½" x 2½"







Block 1

Block 2

Both blocks are made in the same way. Lay out the fabrics for block 1.

Stitch the squares together top two and then the bottom set and then




