Throw size 52" x 52" - unfinished block size 812" x 8½"


## Requitements

Fabrics from the Winter Botanical collection

1. A784.1 - Holly and ivy on light silver with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
2. A786.1 - Winter botanical on grey with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
3. A787.1-Winter botanical on grey with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
4. A789.1-A789.3-Red seed heads with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
5. A784.3-Holly and ivy on natural with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
6. A786.2-Winter botanical on green with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
7. A787.3-Snowberry on dark red with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
8. A789.1 - Silver seed heads with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
9. A785.2 - Pearl dots on silver $-5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-60 \mathrm{~cm}$
10. A785.3-Pearl dots on winter green $-5 / 8 y d-60 \mathrm{~cm}$
11. BB23-Post-box red - $1 / 2 y$ y $-1 / 2 m$
12. BB148-Cream (Pearl) - $11 / 4-1.20 \mathrm{~m}$

Wadding and backing 56" x 56"
All measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1 to 4 you need to cut
$13 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once
$13 \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$
From each of the fabrics 5 to 8 you need to cut
$12 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once
$12 \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
From each of the fabrics 9 and 10 you need to cut
$30 \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
From fabric 11 cut
$36 \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{11 / 2 "}$
From fabric 12 cut
$25 \times 5 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 5 \frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

## Making up the blocks



Block 1


Block 2

Both blocks are made in the same way. Lay out the fabrics for block 1.
Start with the flying geese block. Sew one small triangle to the lager triangle, press back and then do the same to the other side.

make all four the same way.
Stitch the squares together top two and then the bottom set and then
sew together
 rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need 13 in total and block 2 you will sew 12 in total.

## Complete the quilt

Lay out the squares, sashing and blocks as in the main diagram.


Five rows of the quilt. Start with square and sashing row. Pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. This will help when sewing the rows together.

## Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.
Use your favorite method from fabric 11 to bind the quilt.

1. A784.2 - Holly and ivy on winter blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
2. A786.3-Winter botanical on green with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
3. A787.2-Snowberry on dark silver with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
4. A789.2 - Winter green seed heads with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
5. A784.3 - Holly and ivy on natural with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
6. A786.1- Winter botanical on grey with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
7. A787.1-Snowberry on winter blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
8. A786.1 - Winter botanical on grey with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
9. A785.1-Pearl dots on cream pearl $-5 / 8 y d-60 \mathrm{~cm}$
10. A785.2-Pearl dots on silver $-5 / 8 y d-60 \mathrm{~cm}$
11. BB10 - Wiltshire green $-1 / 2 y d-1 / 2 m$
12. BB01 - White - $11 / 4-1.20 \mathrm{~m}$

Wadding and backing 56" x 56"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.


## From each of the fabrics 1 to 4 you need to cut

$13 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once
$13 \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$
From each of the fabrics 5 to 8 you need to cut
$12 \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once
$12 \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$
From each of the fabrics 9 and 10 you need to cut
$30 \times 21 / 22^{1} \times 81 / 2{ }^{1}$
From fabric 11 cut
$36 \times 21 / 2 " \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 12 cut

$25 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
$80 \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$



Block 1


Block 2

Both blocks are made in the same way. Lay out the fabrics for block 1.

Now stitch in rows and the sew the rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need 13 in total and block 2 you will sew 12 in total.

## Complete the quilt

Lay out the squares, sashing and blocks as in the main diagram.


Five rows of the quilt. Start with square and sashing row. Pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. This will help when sewing the rows together.


Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.
Use your favorite method from fabric 11 to bind the quilt.


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
