

Quilt 1 - size 60" x 67" - unfinished block sizes 41/2" x 81/2" - 41/2" x 41/2"



Requirements

Fabrics from the Ocean Pearls collection:

- 1. A826.1 Sea turtle family on light mist with pearl fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 2. A827.1 Fish swirls on sea froth with pearl fat¹/₄
- 3. A828.3 Pearl shells on island blue with pearl fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 4. A829.2 Multi starfish on sunny blue with pearl fat¹⁄₄
- 5. A830.2 Shells and pearls on gentle blue with pearl fat¹/₄
- 6. A826.3 Sea turtle family on dark blue with pearl fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 7. A827.2 Fish swirls on warm mist with pearl fat¹/₄
- 8. A828.2 Pearl shells on morning mist with pearl fat¹/₄
- 9. A829.1 Blue starfish on cream with pearl fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 10. A830.1 Shells and pearls on cream with pearl fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 11. D1 Cream dreams 21/2yd 21/2m
- 12. D8 Island blue dreams 1yd 1m 70cm

Wadding 68" x 75" - Backing 31/2m

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9 you need to cut

5 x 4½" W x 8½" H 5 x 4½" x 4½"

From each of the fabrics 5 and 10 you need to cut

4 x 4½" x 8½" H 4 x 4½" x 4½"

From fabric 11 cut

11 x 2" x 60½" sashing 2 x 2" x 57" top and bottom 400 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 12 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{1}{2}$ " sides (outer border)

2 x 2¹/₂" x 61" top and bottom (outer Border)

Making up the blocks





Block 2


Block 1

Take the squares of fabric 11 and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side on all 400. Place a square onto your strip $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " as in the diagram.



Stitch just on the outer


edge of the pencil line. Cut away so you end up with a ¼" seam, press. Now do the other side the same. You will do exactly the same the other end so it will look like block 1diagram. On fabrics **1,2, 3, 4, 6, 7,8 and 9** will be five of each colour way and four of each with fabrics **5 and 10**. Block 2 This block is made up in the same way as block 1.



You will stitch

You need

each corner but this time it will be the oppsite corners.



five of each colours 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9. For fabrics 5 and 10 you need four again.

Making up the quilt

You will work down the rows so lay out your blocks as in the diagram and sew together. Pressing as you go.

When you have all your rows stitch together. Start with sewin together a sashing and block row together. Work along until you have join all your pieces.

Borders

Take fabric 11 sides strip and sew to the quilt, press back. Next top and bottom.

Now do the same to the outer border to complete the quilt top.


Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. You could quilt it with starfish and Shells.


Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.

Requirements

Fabrics from the Ocean Pearls collection:

- 1. A826.2 Sea turtle family on ocean blue with pearl fat¹/₄
- 2. A827.2 Fish swirls on warm mist with pearl fat¹/₄
- 3. A828.3 Pearl shells on island blue with pearl fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 4. A829.1 Blue starfish on cream with pearl fat¹/₄
- 5. A830.1 Shells and pearls on cream with pearl fat¹/₄
- 6. A826.1 Sea turtle family on light mist with pearl fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 7. A827.3 Fish swirls on deep seas with pearl fat¹/₄
- 8. A828.1 Pearl shells on powdered sand with pearl fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 9. A829.3 Multi starfish on dark blue with pearl fat¹/₄
- 10. A830.3 Shells and pearls on dark blue with pearl fat $\frac{1}{4}$
- 11. BB01 White 21/2yd 21/2m
- 12. BB149 Silver metallic 1yd 1m 70cm

Wadding 68" x 75" - Backing 31/2m

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9 you need to cut

5 x 4½" W x 8½" H 5 x 4½" x 4½"

From each of the fabrics 5 and 10 you need to cut

4 x 4½" x 8½" H 4 x 4½" x 4½"

From fabric 11 cut


11 x 2" x 60½" sashing 2 x 2" x 57" top and bottom 400 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 12 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63¹/₂" sides (outer border) 2 x 2¹/₂" x 61" top and bottom (outer Border)

Making up the blocks






Block 2

Block 1

Take the squares of fabric 11 and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side on all 400. Place a square onto your strip $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " as in the diagram.




Stitch just on the outer edge of the pencil line. Cut away so you end up with a ¼" seam, press. Now do the other side the same. You will do exactly the same the other end so it will look like block 1diagram. On fabrics **1,2, 3, 4, 6, 7,8 and 9** will be five of each colour way and four of each with fabrics **5 and 10**. Block 2 This block is made up in the same way as block 1.



You will stitch

Making up the quilt


Quilting
