Quilt 1 - size 60" x 67" - unfinished block sizes $41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}-41 ⁄ 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Ocean Pearls collection:

1. A826.1-Sea turtle family on light mist with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
2. A827.1-Fish swirls on sea froth with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
3. A828.3-Pearl shells on island blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
4. A829.2 - Multi starfish on sunny blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
5. A830.2-Shells and pearls on gentle blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
6. A826.3 - Sea turtle family on dark blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
7. A827.2 - Fish swirls on warm mist with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
8. A828.2-Pearl shells on morning mist with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
9. A829.1 - Blue starfish on cream with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
10. A830.1 - Shells and pearls on cream with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
11. D1 - Cream dreams $-2 \frac{1}{2}$ yd $-21 / 2 m$
12. D8-Island blue dreams - 1yd -1 m 70 cm

Wadding 68" x 75" - Backing 3½m
All measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

## Cutting

From each of the fabrics $1,2,3,4,6,7,8$ and 9 you need to cut
$5 \times 41122^{\prime \prime}$ W x 81⁄2" H
$5 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From each of the fabrics 5 and 10 you need to cut

$4 \times 41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 11 cut

$11 \times 2$ " x 60 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing
$2 \times 2 " \times 57$ " top and bottom
$400 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 12 cut

$2 \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides (outer border)
$2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61$ " top and bottom (outer Border)

## Making up the blocks



Block 1

## Block 1

Take the squares of fabric 11 and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side on all 400 . Place a square onto your strip $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ as in the diagram.


Stitch just on the outer edge of the pencil line. Cut away so you end up with a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam, press. Now do the other side the same. You will do exactly the same the other end so it will look like block 1diagram. On fabrics 1,2, 3, 4, 6, 7,8 and 9 will be five of each colour way and four of each with fabrics 5 and 10.

Block 2
This block is made up in the same way as block 1 .


You will stitch
each corner but this time it will be the oppsite corners.


You need
five of each colours 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9. For fabrics 5 and 10 you need four again.

## Making up the quilt

You will work down the rows so lay out your blocks as in the diagram and sew together. Pressing as you go.

When you have all your rows stitch together. Start with sewin together a sashing and block row together. Work along until you have join all your pieces.

## Borders

Take fabric 11 sides strip and sew to the quilt, press back. Next top and bottom.
Now do the same to the outer border to complete the quilt top.

## Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. You could quilt it with starfish and Shells.

## Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.

Fabrics from the Ocean Pearls collection:

1. A826.2-Sea turtle family on ocean blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
2. A827.2 - Fish swirls on warm mist with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
3. A828.3-Pearl shells on island blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
4. A829.1 - Blue starfish on cream with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
5. A830.1-Shells and pearls on cream with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
6. A826.1-Sea turtle family on light mist with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
7. A827.3 - Fish swirls on deep seas with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
8. A828.1-Pearl shells on powdered sand with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
9. A829.3-Multi starfish on dark blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
10. A830.3-Shells and pearls on dark blue with pearl - fat $1 / 4$
11. BB01-White $-2 \frac{1}{2}$ yd $-21 / 2 m$
12. BB149 Silver metallic $-1 y d-1 \mathrm{~m} 70 \mathrm{~cm}$

Wadding 68" $\times 75$ " - Backing $3 ½ m$
All measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

## Cutting

## From each of the fabrics $1,2,3,4,6,7,8$ and 9 you need to cut

$5 \times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ W x $81 / 22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$
$5 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From each of the fabrics 5 and 10 you need to cut

$4 \times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 11 cut

$11 \times 2$ " x 601/2" sashing
$2 \times 2 " \times 57$ " top and bottom
$400 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 12 cut

$2 \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides (outer border)
$2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61$ " top and bottom (outer Border)

## Making up the blocks

## Block 1
