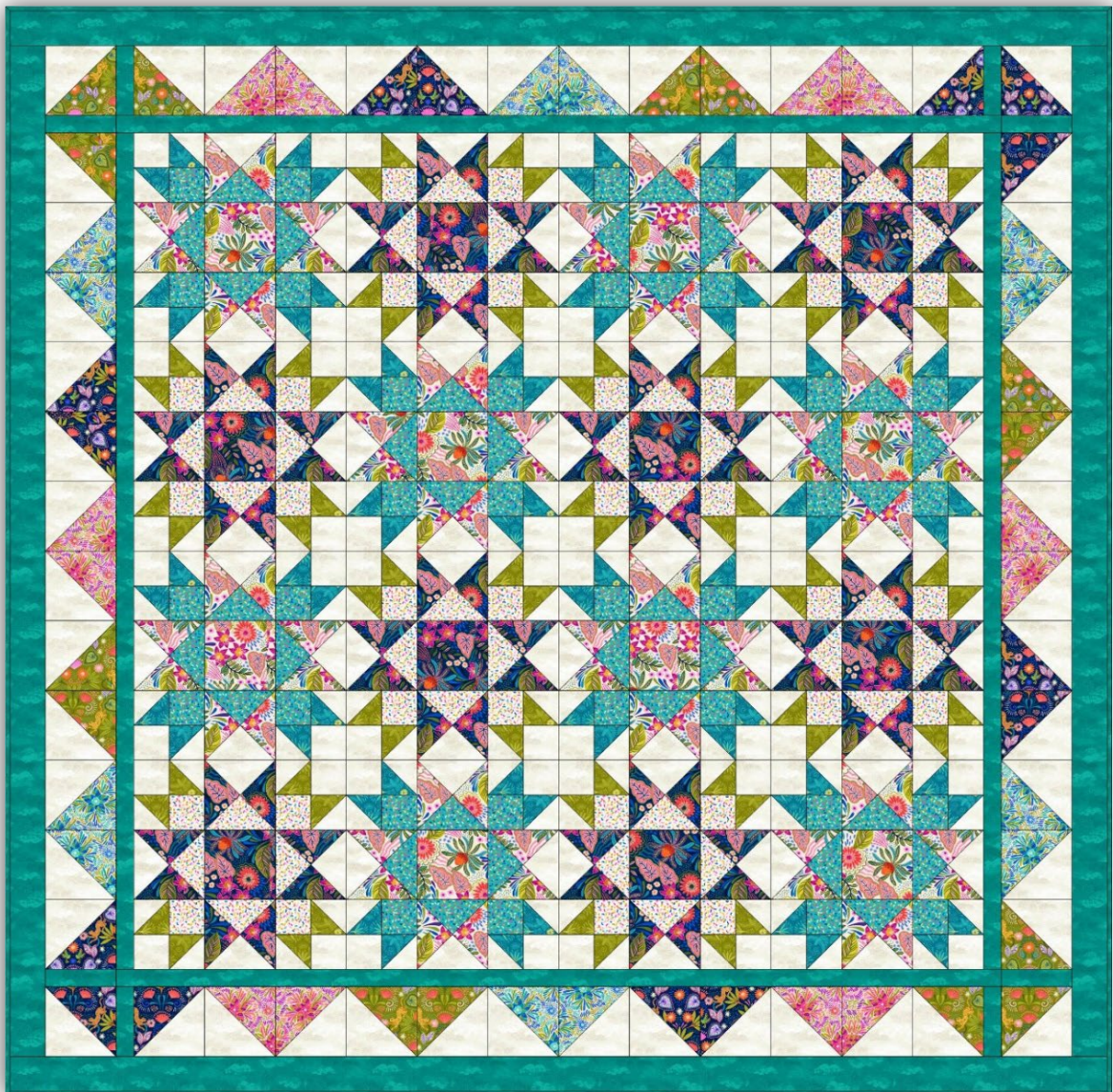

Size of runner 62" x 62" - unfinished block size 12½" x 12½" - 4½" x 4½"



Fabrics from Bahia collection

Requirements

1. A807.1 - Bahia flora on cream - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
2. A808.2 - Carnival on turquoise - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
3. A811.3 - Dark turquoise Bahian hummingbird - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A807.3 - Bahia flora on dark blue - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
5. A808.1 - Carnival on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
6. A811.2 - Jungle green Bahian hummingbird - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. A809.2 - Mirrored jaguar on jungle green - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. A809.3 - Mirrored jaguar on dark blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. A810.1 - Axé blue and green floral on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. A810.2 - Axé pink and green floral on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. D1 - Cream dreams - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m
12. D7 - Jade dreams - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{4}$ m

Wadding and backing 66" x 66"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1 & 4 you need to cut

16 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

8 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 2 & 5 you need to cut

8 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

32 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 3 & 6 you need to cut

32 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 7 & 8 you need to cut

7 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 9 & 10 you need to cut

6 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 11 cut

16 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

26 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

32 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

64 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 12 cut

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom (outer border)

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $58\frac{1}{2}$ " sides (outer border)

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom (inner border)

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " sides inner (border)

8 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (corner sashing pieces)

Making up the blocks



Block 1



Block 2

Both blocks are made up in the same. Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1. Start with the corner pieces. Sew the triangles together to make a square and then stitch in rows. Next stitch your rows together to complete the block. Do all four corners

Middle sets

Sew two small triangles together and then stitch both triangles together to complete the square.

Lay out all the pieces and sew in rows and then stitch all the rows together to complete the block. 8 in total of block 1.

Block 2 is stitch in the same way. Again 8 in total for block 2

Making up the middle block piece.



Lay out your fabric pieces. You will have one pattern and a background fabric. Stitch the two triangles together to make a square. Fabrics 7 and 8 you need seven sets. For fabrics 9 and 10 you will have six sets.

Making up the quilt.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows and if you press your seams in the opposite way each time this will help when sewing the rows together.

Inner border

Sew the sides to the quilt, press.

Next the top and bottom to the quilt.

Middle border

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. 12 blocks for each strip with a strip at each end of fabric 12.

Sew the sides to the quilt, press.

On the top and bottom you will add the strips and a block to each end. Stitch this the quilt.

Outer border

Take the side strips of fabric 12 sew to quilt and top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Maybe flowers or leaves. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 12 for binding the quilt.

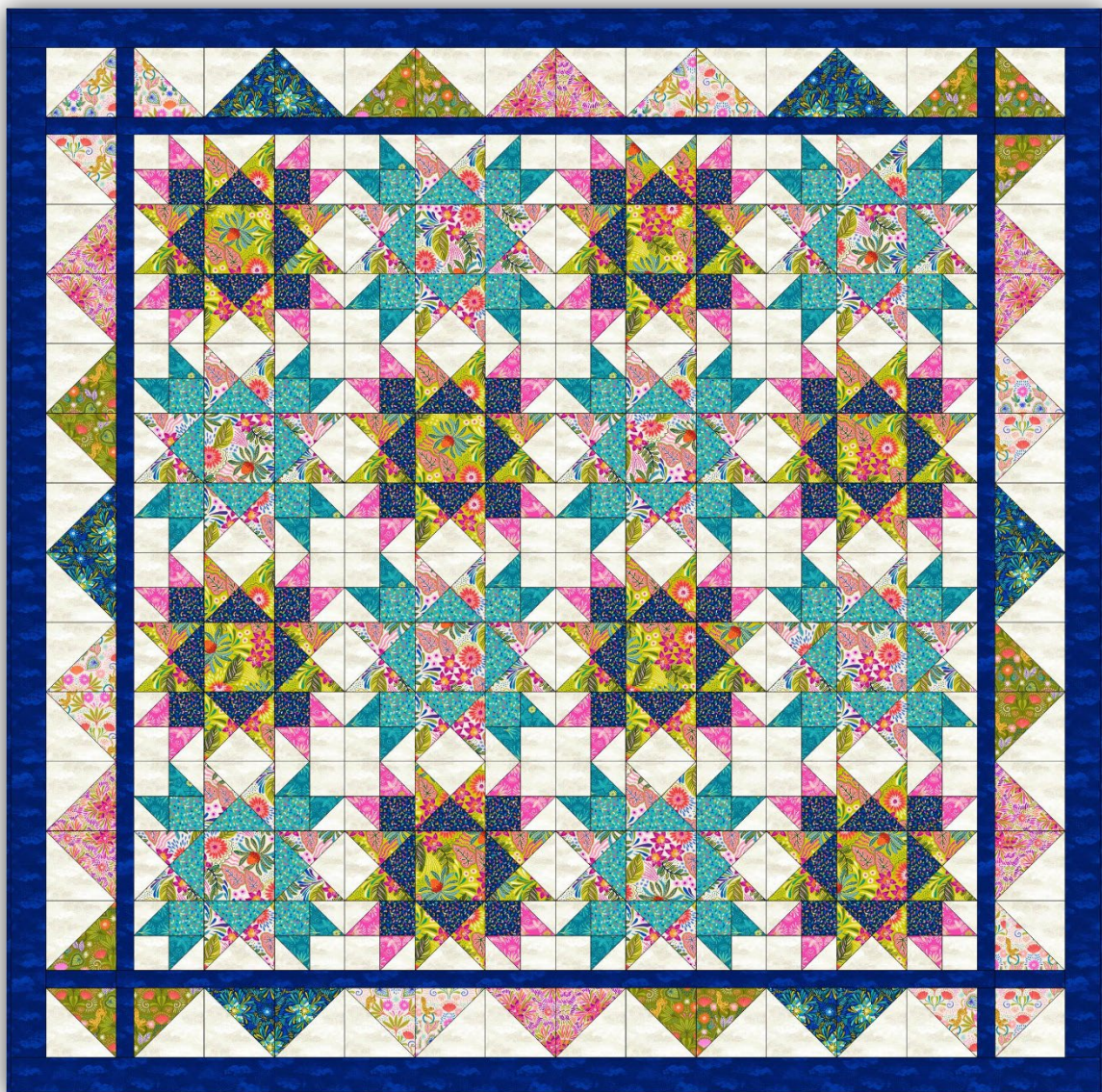

2. A808.3 - Carnival on dark blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
3. A811.1 - Pink Bahian hummingbird - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A807.1 - Bahia flora on cream - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
5. A808.2 - Carnival on turquoise - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
6. A811.3 - Dark turquoise Bahian hummingbird - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. A809.1 - Mirrored jaguar on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. A809.2 - Mirrored jaguar on jungle green - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. A810.2 - Axé pink and green floral on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. A810.3 - Axé blue and green floral on dark blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. D1 - Cream dreams - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m
12. D10 - Dark blue dreams - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{4}$ m

Wadding and backing 66" x 66"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1 & 4 you need to cut

16 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

8 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 2 & 5 you need to cut

8 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

32 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 3 & 6 you need to cut

32 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 7 & 8 you need to cut

7 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 9 & 10 you need to cut

6 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 11 cut

16 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

26 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

32 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

64 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 12 cut

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom (outer border)

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $58\frac{1}{2}$ " sides (outer border)

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom (inner border)

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " sides inner (border)

8 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (corner sashing pieces)

Making up the blocks
