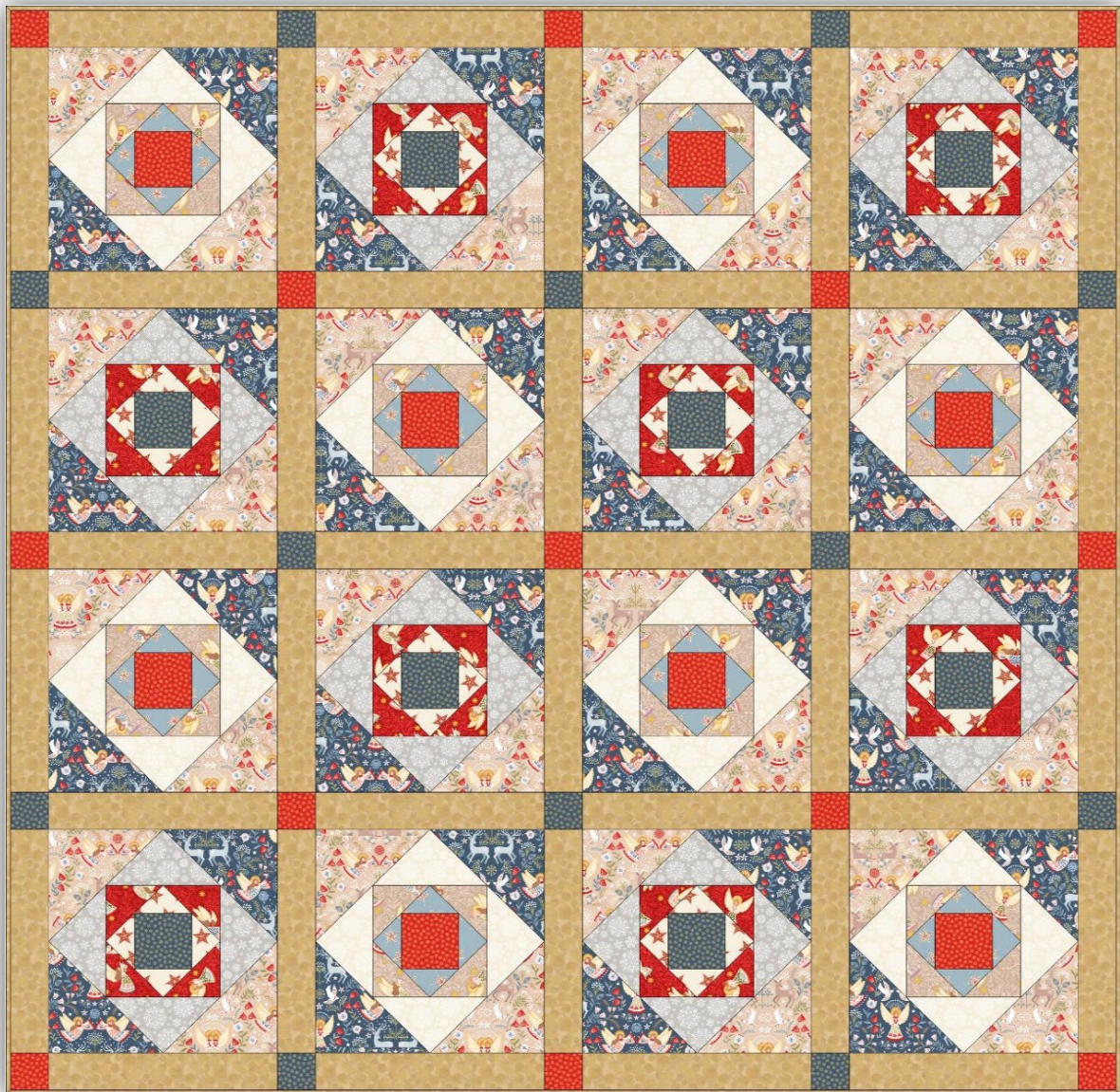

**Fabrics from Peace and Joy collection**

Requirements

1. C108.1 - Peace and Joy on dark cream -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
2. C108.3 - Peace and Joy on festive blue -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
3. C111.1 - Snowflakes on cream -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ m
4. C112.1 - Host of angels on taupe - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. C110.2 - Stars on light blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. C109.2 - Little star on red - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. C111.2 - Snowflakes on light silver -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ m
8. C112.2 - Host of angels on red - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. C110.1 - Stars on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. C109.3 - Little star on festive blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. BB151 - Gold Metallic  $1\frac{1}{8}$ yd - 1.10m

Wadding and backing 62" x 62"

**All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.**

**Cutting**

**From fabric 1 cut - For both blocks**

16 x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right

**From fabric 2 cut - For both blocks**

16 x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from top left to bottom right

**From fabric 3 cut**

8 x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 1)

**From fabric 4 cut - for block 1**

8 x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right

8 x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from top left to bottom right

**From fabric 5 cut**

8 x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 1)

**From fabric 6 cut**

8 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

13 x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

**From fabric 7 cut**





8 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

**From fabric 8 cut - for block 2**

8 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right

8 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once from top left to bottom right

**From fabric 9 cut**

8 x 4¼" x 4¼" cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

**From fabric 10 cut**

8 x 3½" x 3½" (for block 2)

12 x 2½" x 2½"

**From fabric 11 cut**

40 x 2½" x 12½" Sashing

**Making up the blocks**



**Block 1**



**Block 2**

You will see that both blocks are made up in the same way. Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1. Work from the center out, as in the number diagram



To make sure that your triangles are centered, fold the long edge of the triangle and press with your fingers. On the square you will fold in half and press each end and then do the same again when you fold the other way.

Stitch triangles 2 and 3 to the square, press back. Trim dog-ears overhanging the square. Repeat the process with the remaining 2 triangles. Repeat the same process until the final 4 triangles.

Block 2 is made up in the same way. You need 8 in total of block 1 and 8 of block 2.

### **Making up the quilt.**

Lay out the sashing, sashing squares and blocks as in the main diagram. Sew the top row of sashing squares and sashing. Pressing the seams to the right. Next row with be sashing strips and blocks, but this time press your seam in the opposite way as this will help when sewing your rows together. Stitch all the rows together and then sew your rows together to complete the quilt top.

### **Quilting and binding**

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Maybe flowers or leaves. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

### **Binding**

Use your favorite method from fabric 11 for binding the quilt.

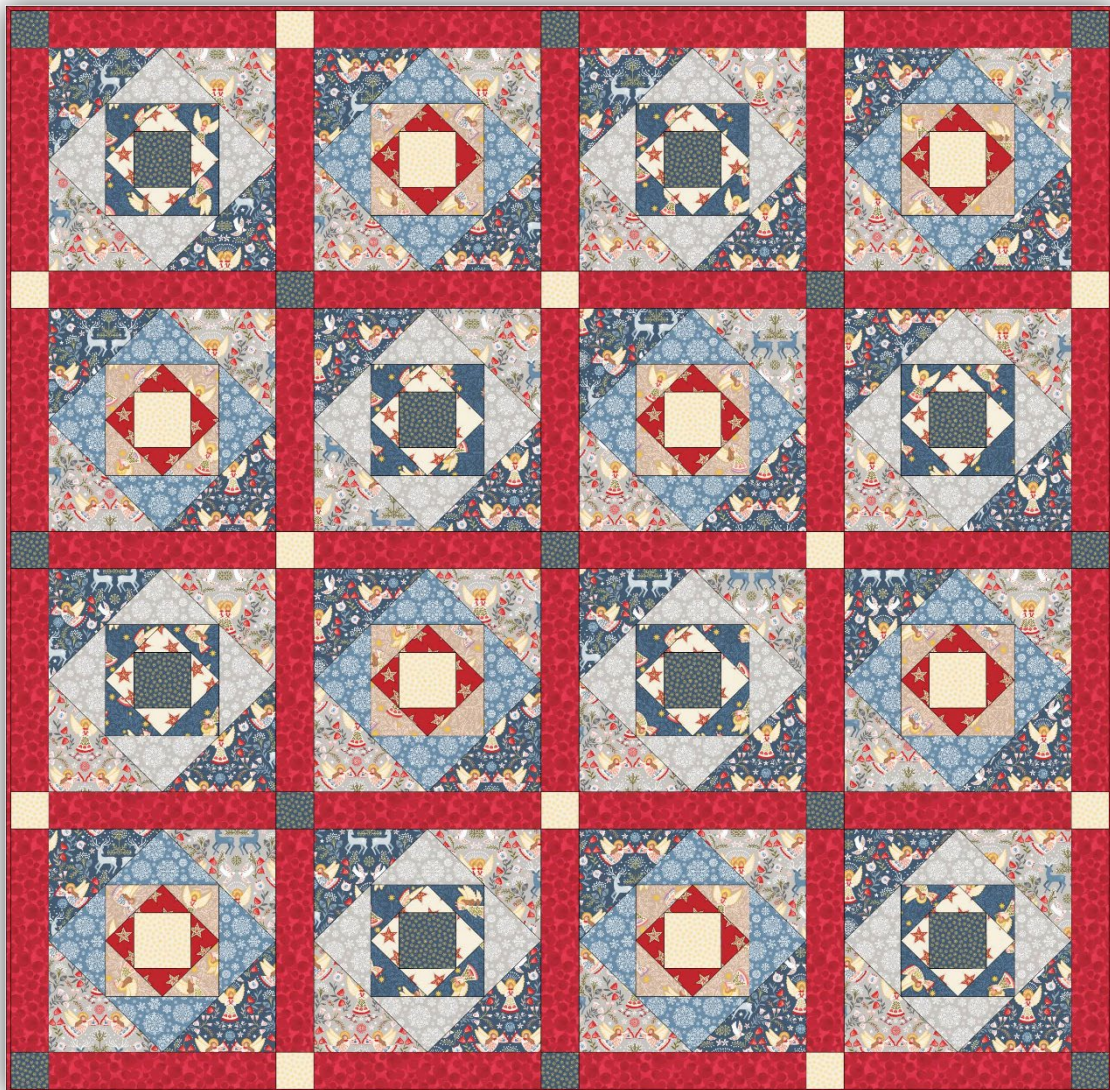

**Fabrics from Peace and Joy collection**

**Requirements**

1. C108.3 - Peace and Joy on festive blue -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
2. C108.2 - Peace and Joy on silver -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
3. C111.2 - Snowflakes on light silver -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ m
4. C112.3 - Host of angels on blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. C110.1 - Stars on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. C109.3 - Little star on festive blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. C111.3 - Snowflakes on iced blue -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ m
8. C112.1 - Host of angels on taupe - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. C110.3 - Stars on red - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. C109.1 - Little star on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. BB189 - Rudolph -  $1\frac{1}{8}$ yd - 1.10m

Wadding and backing 62" x 62"

**All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.**

**Cutting**

**From fabric 1 cut - For both blocks**

16 x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right

**From fabric 2 cut - For both blocks**

16 x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from top left to bottom right

**From fabric 3 cut**

8 x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 1)

**From fabric 4 cut - for block 1**

8 x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right

8 x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from top left to bottom right

**From fabric 5 cut**

8 x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 1)

**From fabric 6 cut**

8 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

13 x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

**From fabric 7 cut**

8 x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)





**From fabric 8 cut - for block 2**

8 x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right  
8 x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" cut in half diagonally once from top left to bottom right

**From fabric 9 cut**

8 x 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

**From fabric 10 cut**

8 x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" (for block 2)  
12 x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

**From fabric 11 cut**

40 x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Sashing

**Making up the blocks**



**Block 1**



**Block 2**

You will see that both blocks are made up in the same way. Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1. Work from the center out, as in the number diagram
