## **Fabrics from Hajime collection**

#### Requirements

- 1. SH1 Hajime Linen 3/4 yd 40cm
- 2. SH9 Multi Stripe Pale blues 3/4yd 40cm
- 3. SH13 Linear Flower blue 3/8yd 40cm
- 4. SH10 Dark blue brushstrokes 7/8yd 80cm
- 5. SH17 Linen and blue flower burst 3/4 yd 40cm
- 6. SH6 Dark blue scroll 3/8yd 40cm
- 7. BB01 White 2%yd 2.20m
- 8. BB29 Indigo 1yd 1m

Wadding and backing 72" x 72"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

### Cutting

#### From fabric 1 cut

26 x 41/2" x 41/2" (block 1)

## From each of the fabrics 2 & 3 you need to cut

78 x 2½" x 2½" (block 1)

#### From fabric 4 cut

 $25 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for blocks 1 & 2)

48 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

## From each of the fabrics 5 & 6 you need to cut

72 x 2½" x 2½" (block 2)

#### From fabric 7 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $66\frac{1}{2}$ " middle border top & bottom

2 x 21/2" x 621/2" middle border sides

12 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

52 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

200 x 2½" x 2½" (block 1 & 2)

#### From fabric 8 cut

2 x 11/2" x 681/2" outer border

2 x 11/2" x 661/2" outer border

2 x 11/2" x 621/2" inner border

2 x 11/2" x 601/2" inner border

## Making up the blocks

#### Block 1

Lay out the fabric pieces as in the diagram. Make up the center part of the block, but look at the placement of the Multi strip fabric before sewing.

Stitch the small squares together in rows and then sew the rows together to make a larger square. You need 13 center in total for block 1

## Flying Gesse block

Place a small triangle onto your large triangle on the long side as in the diagram part 1. Stitch into place and press back. Trim of the little ears. Do the same to the other side to complete the block. Make up all your

flying Gesse block. 52 in total for block 1. Add a small square of background fabric to each side of the Flying Gesse block. Lay out all the pieces for the block and sew in rows and then stitch your rows together to complete the blocks.

#### Block 2

This time you have a Flying Gesse block in the center as well. So, make up as before with block 1. Join the four small square together to make a bigger square. Stitch the rows together and then sew the rows together to complete the center of the block. You need 12 centers in total.

Lay out all your block pieces and sew together as in block 1, But this time you need 12 blocks in total.

## Making up the quilt center.

Lay out all your blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows and then sew your rows together to complete the quilt center. It's a good idea if

you press your seams in the opposite way each time as this help when sewing the rows together.

#### **Borders**

All three borders are sewn in the same way. Stitch the sides, press back and then the top and bottom of the inner border. Next will be your middle border and then last the outer border. To complete your quilt top

## Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. See what you can see in the fabric for ideas for quilting your quilt

## **Binding**

Use your favorite method from fabric 8 to bind the quilt.

## **Fabrics from Hajime collection**

#### Requirements

- 1. SH2 Hajime Indigo ¾yd 40cm
- 2. SH4 Mid blue stitch stripe 3/8yd 40cm
- 3. SH18 Small Floral burst 3/8yd 40cm
- 4. SH14 Dark linen brushstrokes 7/8 yd 80cm
- 5. SH12 Cream flower on blue 3/4 yd 40cm
- 6. SH8 Clouds 3/8 yd 40cm
- 7. BB03 Light grey 23/8yd 2.20m
- 8. BB21 Rock 1yd 1m

Wadding and backing 72" x 72"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

### Cutting

#### From fabric 1 cut

26 x 4½" x 4½" (block 1)

## From each of the fabrics 2 & 3 you need to cut

78 x 2½" x 2½" (block 1)

#### From fabric 4 cut

25 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (for blocks 1 & 2)

48 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

# From each of the fabrics 5 & 6 you need to cut

72 x 21/2" x 21/2" (block 2)

#### From fabric 7 cut

2 x 21/2" x 661/2" middle border top & bottom

2 x 21/2" x 621/2" middle border sides

 $12 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

52 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

200 x 21/2" x 21/2" (block 1 & 2)

#### From fabric 8 cut

2 x 1½" x 68½" outer border

2 x 11/2" x 661/2" outer border

2 x 11/2" x 621/2" inner border

2 x 11/2" x 601/2" inner border

## Making up the blocks





- 2. SH11 Light blue stitch stripe 3/4 yd 40cm
- 3. SH15 Flower burst 3/8 yd 40cm
- 4. SH7 Scratch spot 1/8yd 80cm
- 5. SH16 Linear Flower light blue 3/4 yd 40cm
- 6. SH5 Hex Geo 3/8yd 40cm
- 7. BB01 White 2%yd 2.20m
- 8. BB09 Studland seafoam 1yd 1m

Wadding and backing 72" x 72"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

## **Cutting**

#### From fabric 1 cut

26 x 4½" x 4½" (block 1)

## From each of the fabrics 2 & 3 you need to cut

78 x 2½" x 2½" (block 1)

#### From fabric 4 cut

25 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (for blocks 1 & 2)

48 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

# From each of the fabrics 5 & 6 you need to cut

72 x 21/2" x 21/2" (block 2)

#### From fabric 7 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $66\frac{1}{2}$ " middle border top & bottom

2 x 21/2" x 621/2" middle border sides

 $12 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

52 x 21/8" x 21/8" cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

200 x 21/2" x 21/2" (block 1 & 2)

#### From fabric 8 cut

2 x 1½" x 68½" outer border

2 x 11/2" x 661/2" outer border

2 x 11/2" x 621/2" inner border

2 x 11/2" x 601/2" inner border


