### Requirements

Fabrics from the Secret Winter Garden collection

- 1. F660.2 Owl orchard on dark grey flannel ½yd
- 2. F659.2 Frosted Garden on mist blue flannel 1/2 yd
- 3. F656.1 Secret Garden on frosty grey flannel 1/2 yd
- 4. F658.2 Snowberries on grey flannel fat 1/4
- 5. BBF02 Bumbleberries light grey flannel 1yd
- 6. BBF04 Bumbleberries mid blue flannel 1/2 yd
- 7. BBF03 Bumbleberries dark blue flannel ½yd

Wadding and backing 52" x 52"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

### Cutting

#### From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2½" x 6½" H

32 x 2½" x 5¼" W

#### From fabric 2 cut

16 x 21/2" x 61/2" H

32 x 2½" x 5¼" W

#### From fabric 3 cut

16 x 5½" x 5½"

#### From fabric 4 cut

2 x 41/4" x 41/4" cut in half diagonally twice (border)

24 x 25/8" x 25/8" (border)

#### From fabric 5 cut

2 x 11/2" x 421/2" inner border top & bottom

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border sides

14 x 41/4" x 41/4" inner border

4 x 31/2" x 31/2" corners on inner border

#### From fabric 6 cut

 $32 \times 1'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  top & bottom strips

 $32 \times 1'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$  side strips

32 x 1" x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " in between strips on block

#### From fabric 7 cut

28 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (border)

### Making up the block.





Block 1

Block 2

Both blocks are made up in the same way. It's just the colour way that is different. Lay out the fabric pieces for the block 1. Sew a strip of fabric 6 to each side of the center square, press back. Next stitch the strips to the top & bottom.

Add each of the outer side strips to the block. Now sew the top and bottom strips to the center strip and then stitch to the block.

In total 8 of block 1 and 8 of block 2.

## Stitching quilt center.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagonally. Press the seam in the opposite way each time as will help when sewing your rows together.

Two of the rows.



#### **Border**

Lay out your fabric pieces for the border. Stitch the two small triangles together.

sew four of each for the start and finished of the border strips. Next stitch a small triangle to each side of the square as in the diagram.



you need to sew 24 in total.

As in the main diagram lay out the fabric pieces for each border strip.

Sew the small triangle to a larger triangle on each row. Keep working along the row until all pieces are stitch. On the top and bottom strip sew a square to each end.

Stitch the border sides to the quilt, press back and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt.


## Quilting

- 3. F656.1 Secret Garden on midnight blue flannel 1/2 yd
- 4. F658.3 Snowberries on ice blue flannel fat 1/4
- 5. BBF04 Bumbleberries mid blue flannel 1yd
- 6. BBF03 Bumbleberries dark blue flannel ½yd
- 7. BBF02 Bumbleberries light grey flannel ½yd

Wadding and backing 52" x 52"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

### Cutting

#### From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2½" x 6½" H

32 x 2½" x 5¼" W

#### From fabric 2 cut

16 x 2½" x 6½" H

32 x 2½" x 5¼" W

#### From fabric 3 cut

16 x 5½" x 5½"

#### From fabric 4 cut

2 x 41/4" x 41/4" cut in half diagonally twice (border)

24 x 25/8" x 25/8" (border)

#### From fabric 5 cut

2 x 11/2" x 421/2" inner border top & bottom

2 x 11/2" x 401/2" inner border sides

14 x 41/4" x 41/4" inner border

4 x 3½" x 3½" corners on inner border

#### From fabric 6 cut

 $32 \times 1'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''' \text{ top } \& \text{ bottom strips}$ 

 $32 \times 1'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$  side strips

32 x 1" x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " in between strips on block

#### From fabric 7 cut

28 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (border)

## Making up the block.





Block 1

Block 2

- 5. BBF03 Bumbleberries dark blue flannel 1yd
- 6. BBF04 Bumbleberries mid blue flannel ½yd
- 7. BBF02 Bumbleberries light grey flannel 1/2 yd

Wadding and backing 52" x 52"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

16 x 2½" x 6½" H

32 x 2½" x 5¼" W

#### From fabric 2 cut

16 x 2½" x 6½" H

32 x 2½" x 5¼" W

#### From fabric 3 cut

16 x 5½" x 5½"

#### From fabric 4 cut

2 x 41/4" x 41/4" cut in half diagonally twice (border)

24 x 25/8" x 25/8" (border)

#### From fabric 5 cut

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $42\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border top & bottom

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border sides

14 x 41/4" x 41/4" inner border

4 x 3½" x 3½" corners on inner border

#### From fabric 6 cut

 $32 \times 1'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  top & bottom strips

 $32 \times 1'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$  side strips

32 x 1" x 21/2" in between strips on block

#### From fabric 7 cut

28 x 31/8" x 31/8" cut in half diagonally once (border)

### Making up the block.
