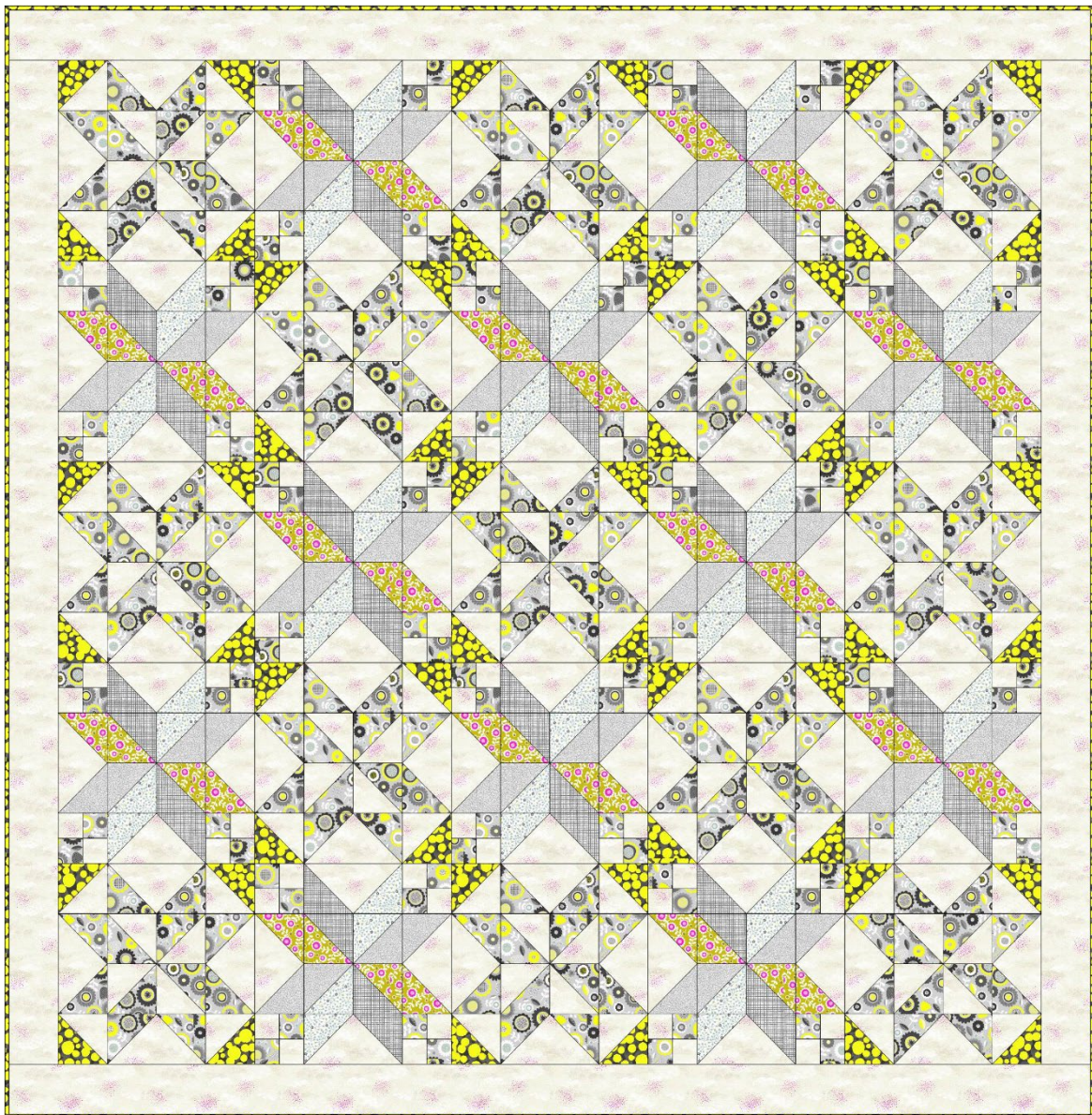

Size of quilt 66" x 66" - unfinished block size 12½" x 12½"



Main Diagram

Fabrics from the Inflorescence collection:

1. A856.2 - Multi sketchbook flowers with pink neon - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - 1.10m
2. A857.1 - Neon yellow grid with yellow neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. A858.3 - Grid flowers on charcoal with yellow neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. A859.3 - Charcoal on white small flowers with pink neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. A860.2 - Yellow neon scribble on grey with yellow neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. D22 - Grey with yellow neon limited edition Dreams $2\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 2.60m
7. BB031 - Cream and pink neon Bumbleberries with pink neon - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm

Wadding and backing 72" x 72"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

78 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)
192 x 2" x 2" (block 2)

From each of the fabric 2, 3, 4 and 5 you need to cut

24 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom outer border
2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " sides (outer border)
25 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally once (for both blocks)
26 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)
96 x 2" x 2" (block 2)

From fabric 7 cut

26 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

Making up the blocks

Block 1 – Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1 as in the diagram.

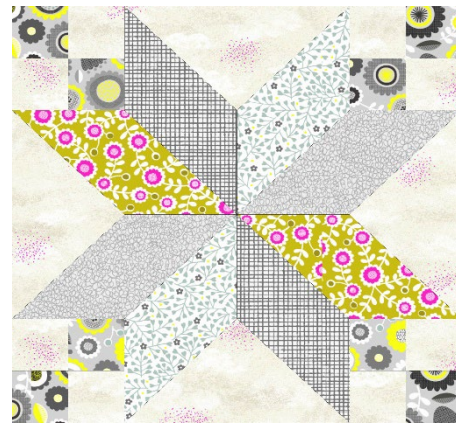
Start with the corner pieces by sewing the two small triangles together to make a square. Do the same to the centre small triangles to make the squares. Stitch in rows and the rows together to make the centre square.

Flying Geese blocks – Sew a small triangle to each side of the larger triangle to complete the block. Lay out the piece's ad in block 1 diagram and stitch in rows and then the rows together to complete the block.

You need 13 of block 1 total.



Block 1



Block 2

Block 2 is made up in the same way as block 1 but in the corners, you will have the small squares. Stitch the squares together in rows and then sew together to make a square.

Look at the fabric colour lay out for the block. You need 12 blocks in total.

Making up the quilt top.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram and stitch in rows, pressing the seams in the opposite way each time as this help when sewing the rows together.

Border

Sew the sides to the quilt, press and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

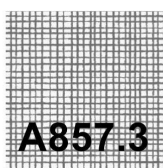
Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 7 for binding the quilt.

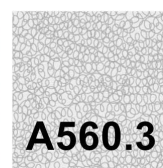

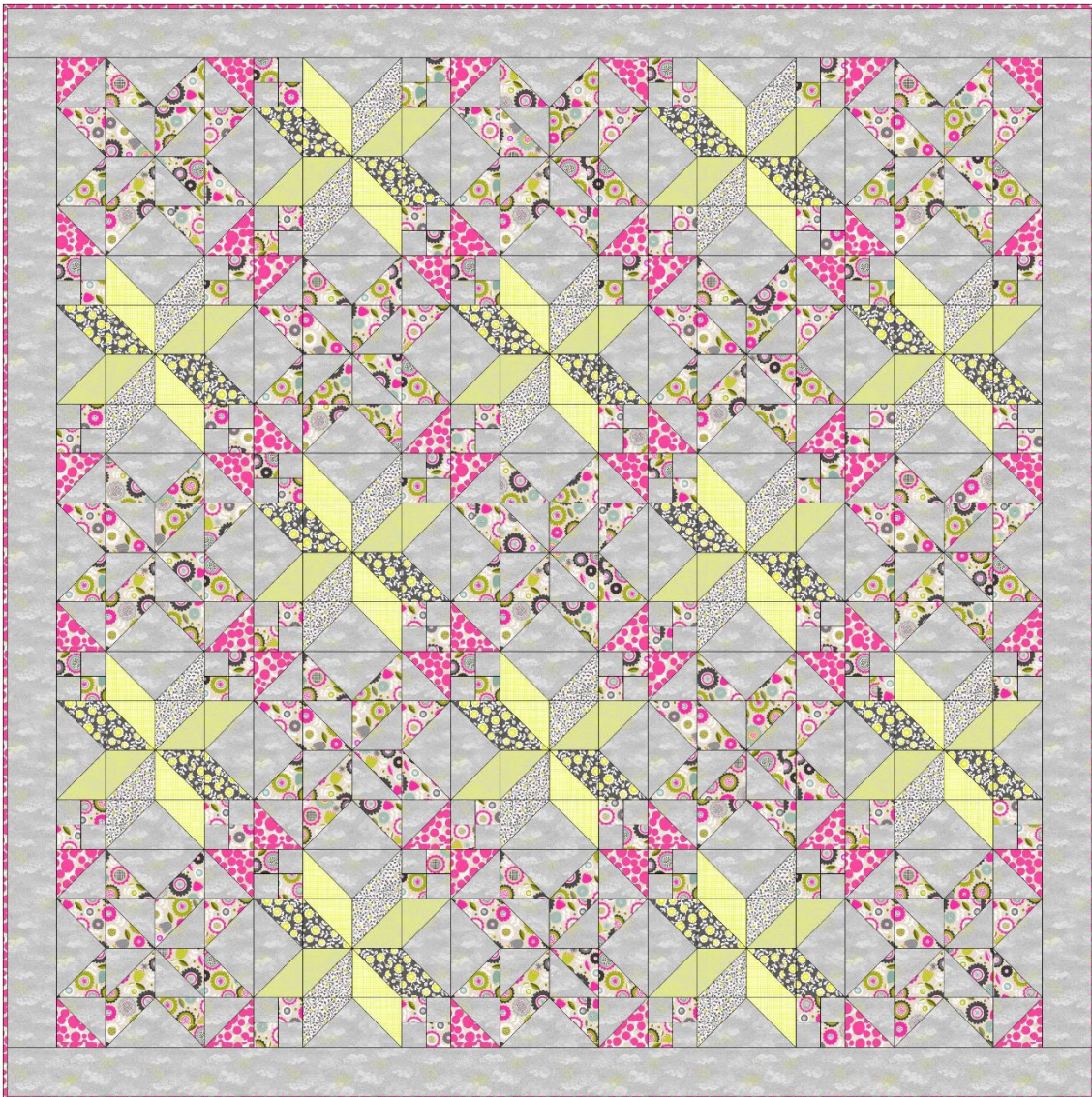

Fabrics from the Inflorescence collection:

1. A856.2 - Multi sketchbook flowers with pink neon - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - 1.10m
2. A857.1 - Neon yellow grid with yellow neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. A858.3 - Grid flowers on charcoal with yellow neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. A859.3 - Charcoal on white small flowers with pink neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. A860.2 - Yellow neon scribble on grey with yellow neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. D22 - Grey with yellow neon limited edition Dreams $2\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 2.60m
7. BB031 - Cream and pink neon Bumbleberries with pink neon - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm

Wadding and backing 72" x 72"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

78 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)
192 x 2" x 2" (block 2)

From each of the fabric 2, 3, 4 and 5 you need to cut

24 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom outer border
2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " sides (outer border)
25 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally once (for both blocks)
26 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)
96 x 2" x 2" (block 2)

From fabric 7 cut

26 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

Making up the blocks

Block 1 – Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1 as in the diagram.

Start with the corner pieces by sewing the two small triangles together to make a square. Do the same to the centre small triangles to make the squares. Stitch in rows and the rows together to make the centre square.

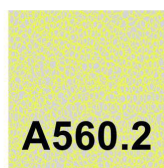

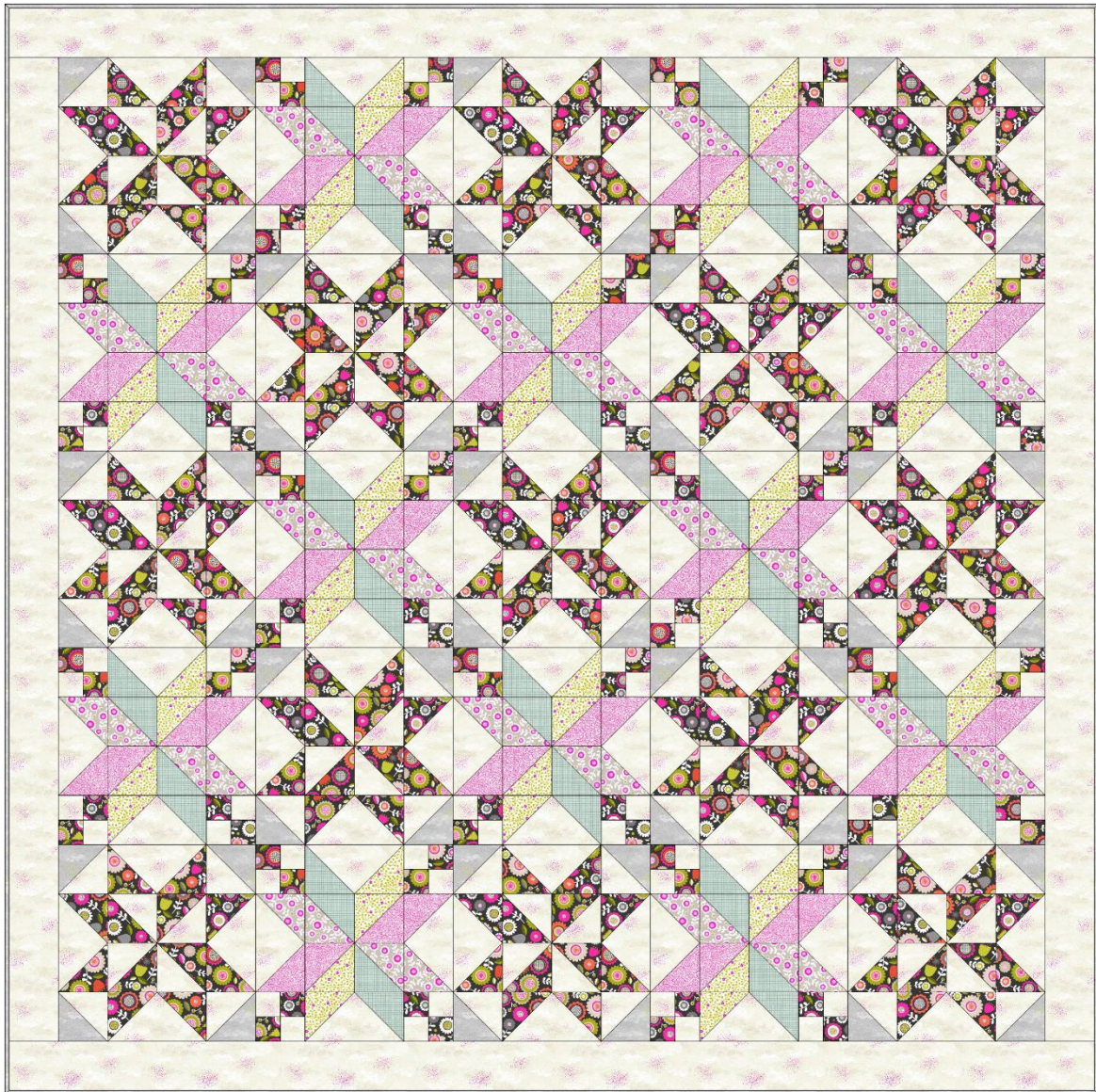

Fabrics from the Inflorescence collection:

1. A856.3 - Dark sketchbook flowers with pink neon - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - 1.10m
2. A857.2 - Aqua blue grid - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. A858.1 - Grid flowers on warm grey with pink neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. A859.2 - Chartreuse on white small flowers with pink neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. A860.1 - Pink neon scribble with pink neon - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. D21 - Cream with pink neon limited edition Dreams - $2\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 2.60m
7. D22 - Grey with yellow neon limited edition Dreams - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm

Wadding and backing 72" x 72"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

78 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

192 x 2" x 2" (block 2)

From each of the fabric 2, 3, 4 and 5 you need to cut

24 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom outer border

2 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " sides (outer border)

25 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally once (for both blocks)

26 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

96 x 2" x 2" (block 2)

From fabric 7 cut

26 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

Making up the blocks

Block 1 – Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1 as in the diagram.
