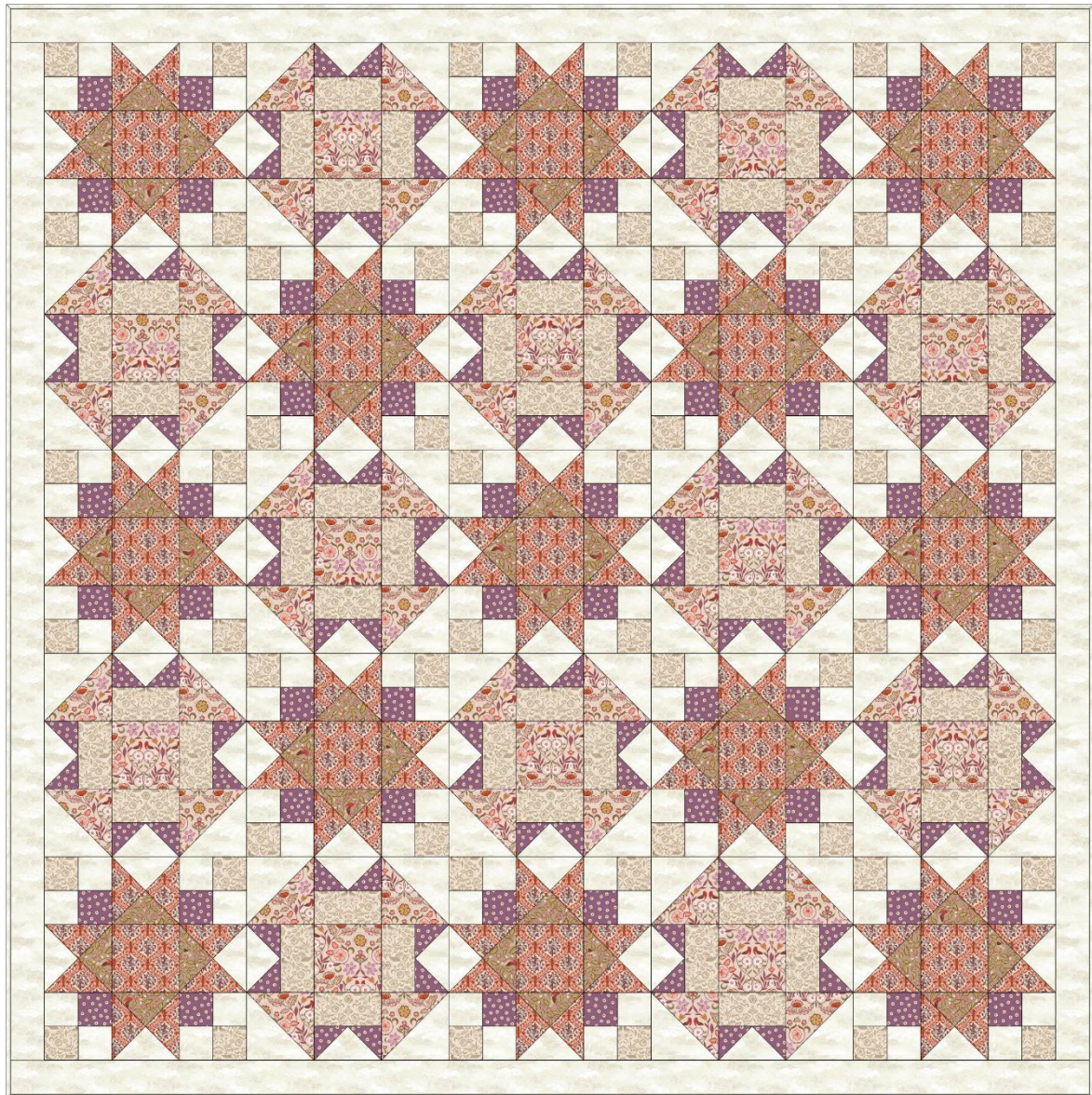

Size of quilt 64" x 64" - unfinished block sizes 12½" x 12½"

Fabrics from Isabella collection

Requirements

1. A851.1 - Isabella spiced plum - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ m
2. A852.3 - Bramley floral on blackberry - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
3. A853.2 - Hidcote tree on terracotta - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ m
4. A854.1 - Isabella small cream - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
5. A855.1 - Arts & crafts birds on dark taupe - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. D1 - Cream dreams - $2\frac{1}{4}$ yd - 2.30m

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

24 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

12 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 2 cut

48 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

52 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

26 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

13 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

48 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

52 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 5 cut

13 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

From fabric 6 cut

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " border top & bottom

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " border sides

25 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for both blocks)



24 x 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

104 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

Making up the blocks

Block 1

Lay out the fabric pieces for the block as in diagram 1.

On each of the corners you will join the small squares together to make a larger square.

Next sew together two small triangles on the short sides and then stitch together to make a square. Sew them in rows and then the rows together to complete the block.

For block 1 you need 13 in total.

Block 2

Place your fabric pieces as in the block 2 diagram. Make up the corners by stitching the two triangles together to make a square.

Next the Flying Geese block.

Sew a small triangle on the long side to the short side of the larger triangle, press. Do the same to the other side. Now stitch your 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric piece to your Flying Geese block. Stitch the other three in the same way.

Again, sew in rows and then the rows together to complete the block.

You need 12 of block 2 in total.

Making up the quilt centre.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram.

Stitch in rows pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. As this will help when sewing your rows together.

Next sew the rows together to complete the quilt centre.

Border

Sew the sides strips to the quilt and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

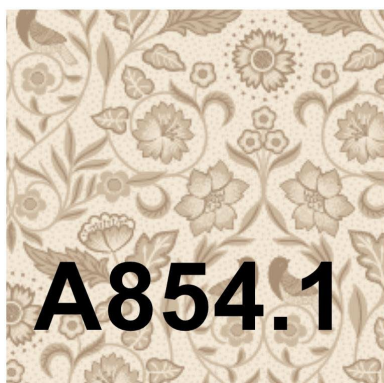
Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Maybe flowers. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

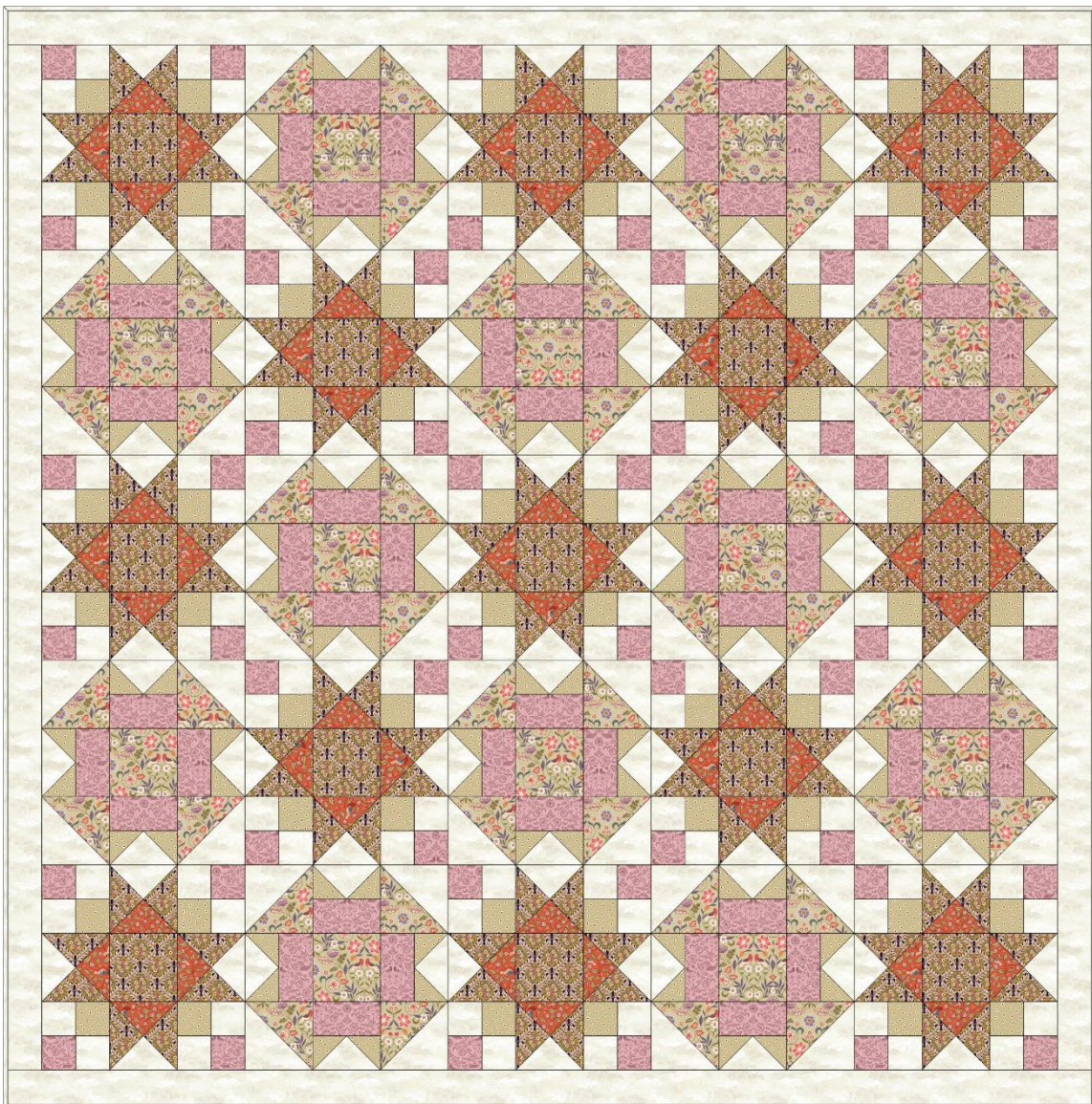
Use your favorite method from fabric 6 for binding the quilt.

Requirements

1. A851.2 - Isabella rose and lavenders - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ m
2. A852.1 - Bramley floral on dark linen - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
3. A853.3 - Hidcote tree on darkest plum - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ m
4. A854.3 - Isabella small mauve - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
5. A855.2 - Arts & crafts birds on soft terracotta - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. D1 - Cream dreams - $2\frac{1}{4}$ yd - 2.30m

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

24 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

12 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 2 cut

48 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

52 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

26 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

13 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

48 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

52 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 5 cut

13 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

From fabric 6 cut

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " border top & bottom

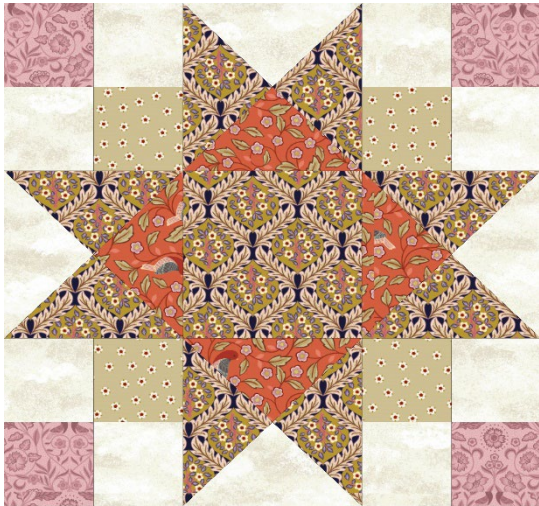
2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " border sides

25 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for both blocks)

24 x 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

104 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

Making up the blocks

Block 1

Lay out the fabric pieces for the block as in diagram 1.

On each of the corners you will join the small squares together to make a larger square.

Next sew together two small triangles on the short sides and then stitch together to make a square. Sew them in rows and then the rows together to complete the block.

For block 1 you need 13 in total.

Block 2

Place your fabric pieces as in the block 2 diagram. Make up the corners by stitching the two triangles together to make a square.

Next the Flying Geese block.

Sew a small triangle on the long side to the short side of the larger triangle, press. Do the same to the other side. Now stitch your 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric piece to your Flying Geese block. Stitch the other three in the same way.

Again, sew in rows and then the rows together to complete the block.

You need 12 of block 2 in total.

Making up the quilt centre.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram.

Stitch in rows pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. As this will help when sewing your rows together.

Next sew the rows together to complete the quilt centre.

Border

Sew the sides strips to the quilt and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

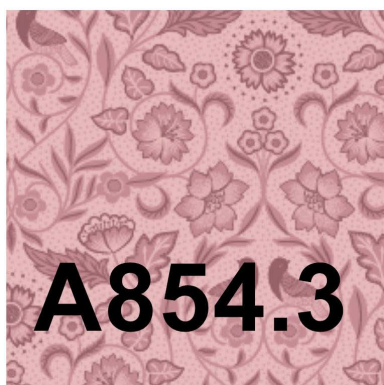
Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

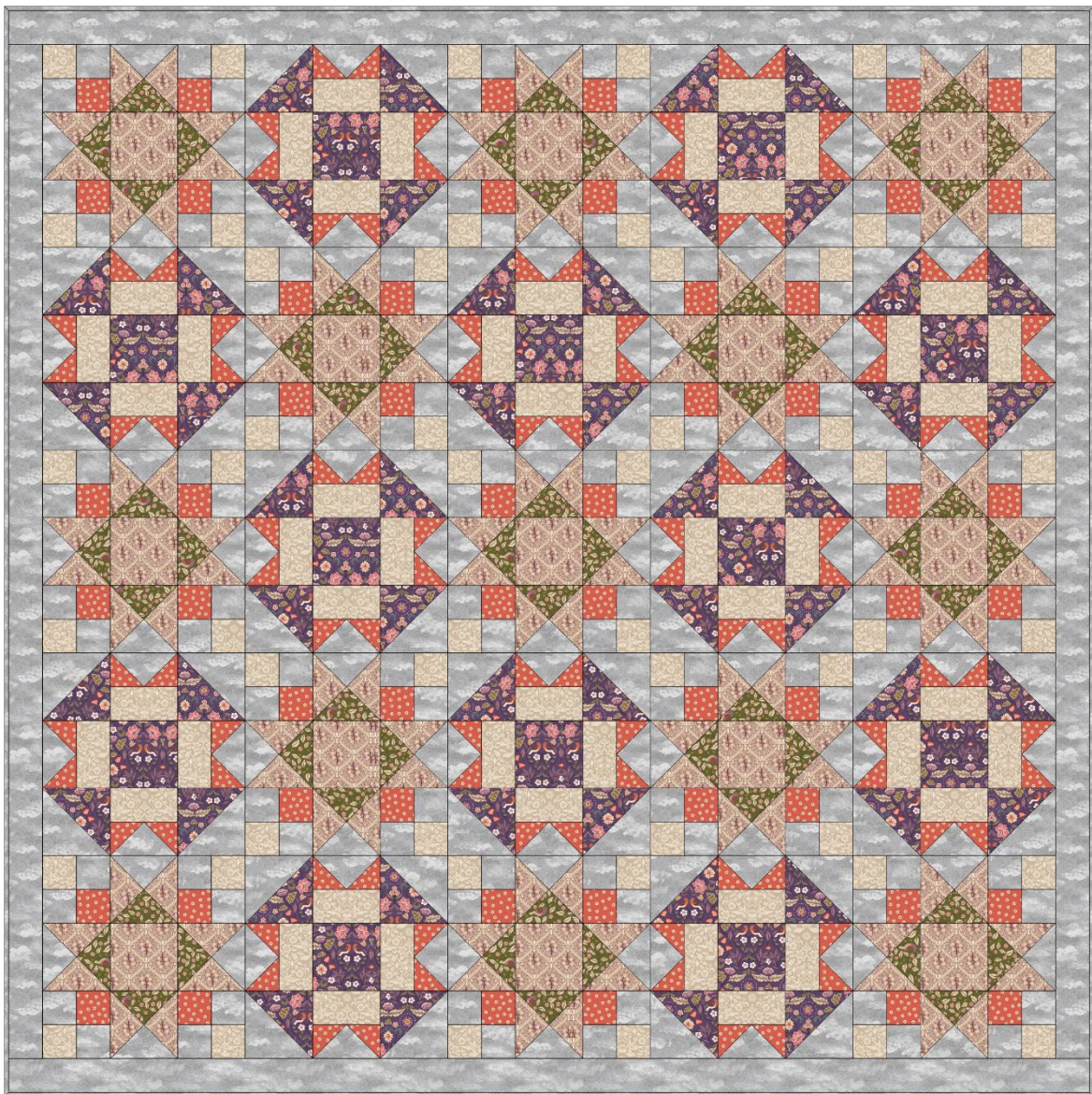

1. A851.3 - Isabella dark plum - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ m
2. A852.2 - Bramley floral on reddish - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
3. A853.1 - Hidcote tree on cream - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ m
4. A854.2 - Isabella small taupe - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
5. A855.3 - Arts & crafts birds on forest green - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. D19 - Grey dreams - $2\frac{1}{4}$ yd - 2.30m

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

24 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

12 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 2 cut

48 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

52 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

26 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

13 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

48 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

52 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 5 cut

13 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

From fabric 6 cut

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " border top & bottom

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " border sides

25 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for both blocks)



24 x 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

104 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

Making up the blocks
