


Designed and made by Sally Ablett - Throw 1 - Size 55" x 55" Unfinished block size $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " - sashing block strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "



Main diagram

Fabrics from Small things Country Garden collection

Requirements

- 1. SM82 Small things ladybirds fat 1/4
- 2. SM84 Small things caterpillars fat1/4
- 3. SM85 Small things frogs 3/8yd 40cm
- 4. SM86 Small things snails 3/8yd 40cm
- 5. SM88 Small things bunnies and tulips ½yd ½m
- 6. SM91 Small things dragonflies and lily of the valley 3/8yd 40cm
- 7. SM92 Small things blossom fat 1/4
- 8. SM94 Small things blossom ½yd ½m
- 9. SM95 Small things birds and nests 5/8 yd 60cm
- 10. SM96 Small things country garden 3/4 yd 40cm
- 11. BB01 White 1yd -1m
- 12. BB03 Light grey 3/4yd 3/4m

Wadding and backing 60" x 60"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2½" x 2½" (block 2)

From fabric 2 cut

8 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

From fabric 3 cut

10 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

From fabric 5

6 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (sashing)

20 x21/2" x 21/2" (block 1)

From fabric 6 cut

6 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (sashing)

From fabric 7 cut

5 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

From fabric 8 cut

12 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (sashing)

From fabric 9 cut

2 x 2" x 52½" outer border sides

2 x 2" x 55½" outer border top & bottom

From fabric 10 cut

25 x 4½" x 4½" (blocks 1, 2 and sashing)

From fabric 11 cut

12 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (blocks 1 & 2)

24 x 4½" x 4½" (sashing)


From fabric 12 cut


9 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (blocks 1 & 2)

36 x 2½" x 4½" (blocks 1 & 2)

36 x 2½" x 2½" (blocks 1 & 2)

Making up the blocks







Block 1

Diagram 1 will be in blocks 1 and 2.

Diagram 2 will be in the blocks and the sashing.

Blocks 1 & 2 are made up in the same way.

Working on block 1 look at the diagram for the placement of fabric.

The corner squares you need to stitch A square to a B square, press and then sew this strip to C. Make up all four in the same way but remember the background fabric will be on the outside of the blocks.

Next the triangle block.

Sew two small triangles together A to B. Do the same to the other side and then stitch the two together to make a square.

Lay out all pieces as in block diagram and sew in rows and the stitch the rows together to complete the block. 5 in total for block 1 and 4 in total for block 2.

Sashing strips.



Look at the main diagram for fabric lay out for each sashing strip. The end of each strip is made up as before in the triangle blocks. Sew a triangle block to each end of a background square $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Making up the quilt top.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram and sew in rows.

The first row will be sashing strips and squares. Next row sashing and blocks. Keep working down the quilt top until you have completed the quilt centre.

Border.

Sew the side strips to the quilt, press back then the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Maybe flowers. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding


Use your favorite method from fabric 9 for binding the quilt.

Main diagram

Fabrics from Small things Country Garden collection

Requirements

- 1. SM87 Small things bees and daffodils fat 1/4
- 2. SM90 Small things hedgehogs and bluebells fat1/4
- 3. SM93 Small things chicks 3/2 yd 40cm
- 4. SM88 Small things bunnies and tulips 3/4 yd 40cm
- 5. SM82 Small things ladybirds ½yd ½m
- 6. SM92 Small things blossom 3/4yd 40cm
- 7. SM83 Small things butterflies fat 1/4
- 8. SM89 Small things butterflies and irises ½yd ½m
- 9. SM96 Small things country garden 5/8yd 60cm
- 10. SM95 Small things birds and nests 3/4 yd 40cm
- 11. BB01 White 1yd 1m
- 12. BB09 Studland seafoam 3/4yd 3/4m

Wadding and backing 60" x 60"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2½" x 2½" (block 2)

From fabric 2 cut

 $8 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

From fabric 3 cut

10 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

From fabric 5

6 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (sashing)

20 x2½" x 2½" (block 1)

From fabric 6 cut

6 x 5½" x 5½" cut in half diagonally twice (sashing)

From fabric t cut

 $5 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

From fabric 8 cut

12 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (sashing)

From fabric 9 cut

2 x 2" x 521/2" outer border sides

2 x 2" x 55½" outer border top & bottom

From fabric 10 cut

 $25 \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (blocks 1, 2 and sashing)

From fabric 11 cut

12 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice (blocks 1 & 2)

24 x 4½" x 4½" (sashing)


From fabric 12 cut

 $9 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (blocks 1 & 2)

36 x 2½" x 4½" (blocks 1 & 2)

36 x 2½" x 2½" (blocks 1 & 2)


Making up the blocks






Block 1 Block 2

Diagram 1 will be in blocks 1 and 2.

Diagram 2 will be in the blocks and the sashing.

Blocks 1 & 2 are made up in the same way.

Working on block 1 look at the diagram for the placement of fabric.


The corner squares you need to stitch A square to a B square, press and then sew this strip to C. Make up all four in the same way but remember the background fabric will be on the outside of the blocks.

Next the triangle block.

Sew two small triangles together A to B. Do the same to the other side and then stitch the two together to make a square.

Lay out all the pieces as in block diagram and sew in rows and the stitch the rows together to complete the block. 5 in total for block 1 and 4 in total for block 2.

Sashing strips.



Look at the main diagram for fabric lay out for each sashing strip. The end of each strip is made up as before in the triangle blocks. Sew a triangle block to each end of a background square $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Making up the quilt top.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram and sew in rows.

The first row will be sashing strips and squares. Next row sashing and blocks. Keep working down the quilt top until you have completed the quilt centre.

Border.

Sew the side strips to the quilt, press back then the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Maybe flowers. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 9 for binding the quilt.
