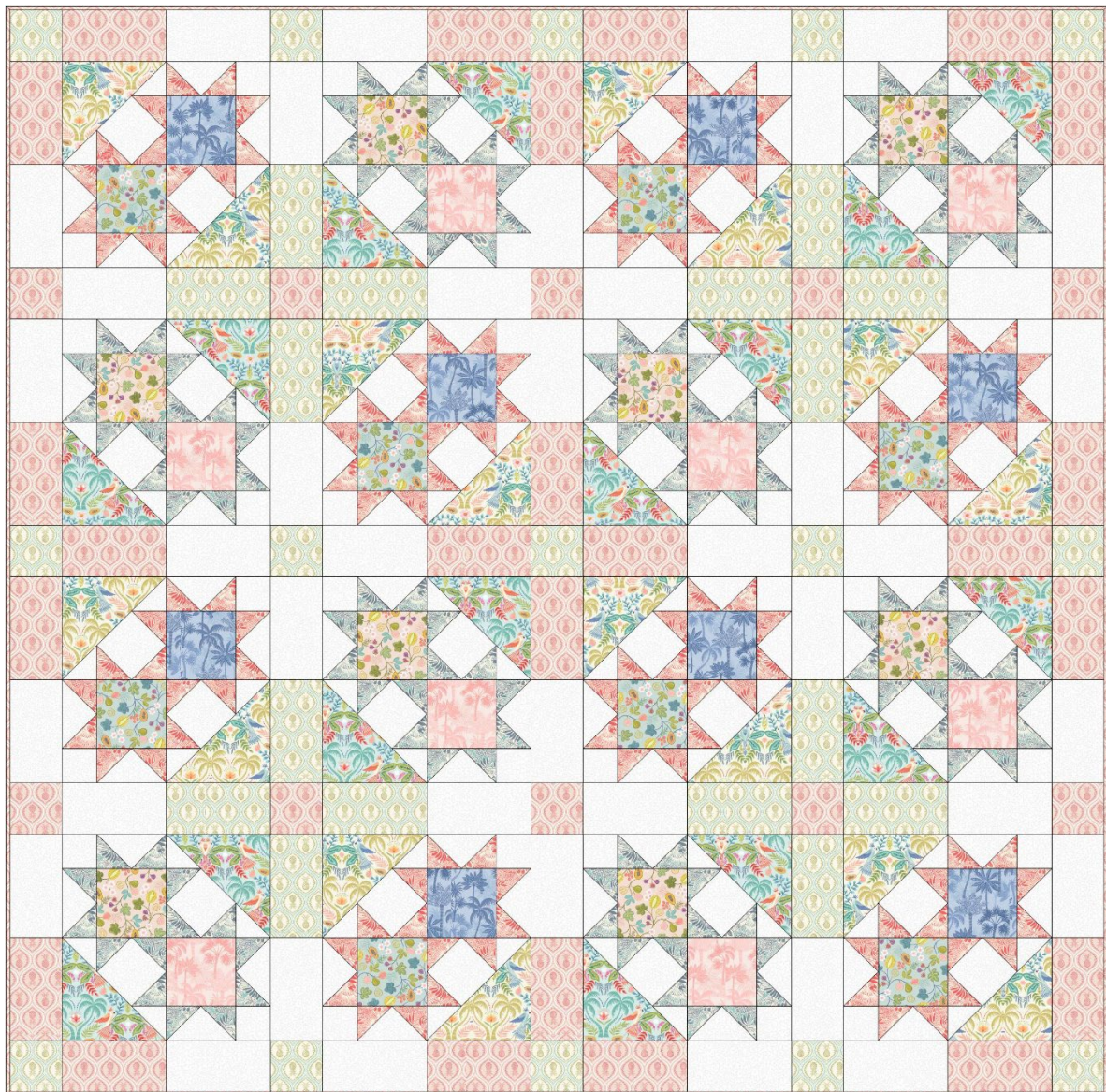

Fabrics from Paradise collection

Requirements

1. A887.A - Paradise on cream - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
2. A891.C - Paradise parrots on coral red - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
3. A890.B - Paradise fruit on sea breeze - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A889.C - Tropical trees on blue sky - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A887.C - Paradise on aqua - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
6. A891.B - Paradise parrots on turquoise - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
7. A890.A - Paradise fruit on light guava - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. A889.B - Tropical trees on pink - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. A888.A - Paradise pineapples on cream - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
10. A888.C - Paradise pineapple on lychee - $\frac{3}{4}$
11. TT27.A - White on white tiny leaves - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut - for block 1

8 x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - from bottom left to top right

From fabric 2 cut

56 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - for block 1

From each of the fabrics 3 & 4 cut

8 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - for block 1

From fabric 5 cut - for block 2

8 x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - from top left to bottom right

From fabric 6 cut

56 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - for block 2

From each of the fabrics 7 & 8 cut

8 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - for block 2

From fabric 9 cut

8 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " W x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " H - sashing strips

8 x 3½" H x 6½" W - sashing strips

15 x 3½" x 3½" - sashing

From fabric 10 cut

12 x 3½" H x 6½" W - sashing strips

12 x 3½" W x 6½" H - sashing strips

10 x 3½" x 3½" - sashing

From fabric 11 cut

40 x 3½" x 6½" - sashing strips

16 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice - for both blocks

32 x 3⅜" x 3⅜" - for both blocks

32 x 2⅞" x 2⅞" cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks

Making up the blocks

Both blocks are made up in the same way. Block 2 will be a mirror image of block 1



Block 1



Block 2

Block 2 will be made up in the same way but placement will be a mirror image of block 1.

Each of the blocks are made up in four quarters.



Top left quarter



Top right quarter



Bottom left quarter



Bottom right quarter

Start with the top left quarter. Sew the two small triangles together. Numbers 1 and 2. Stitch to number 3 square and then add number 4. Next sew the two triangles together to make a square. You will do the same to the bottom right quarter. Now the top right part of the block.

Make up the Flying Geese blocks by sewing the small triangles to each side of the larger triangle. Stitch one of the Flying Geese blocks to the large square. Next add a small square to the other Flying Geese block and stitch to the part block. Do the same to the bottom left part of the block.

Sew in rows and then the rows together to complete the block.

8 in total of block 1

Block 2 will be made up in the same way but placement will be a mirror image of block 1. 8 blocks in total.

Sashing strips.



Look at the placement of colours for each strip. Sew number 1 to number 2 to together to have a 3½" x 12½" strip.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows, pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. This will help when sewing the rows together.

Stitch your rows together to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

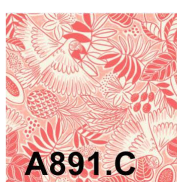
Maybe flowers. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 10 for binding the quilt.

Requirements

1. A887.C - Paradise on aqua - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
2. A891.B - Paradise parrots on turquoise - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
3. A890.C - Paradise fruit on Atlantic blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A889.B - Tropical trees on pink - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A887.B - Paradise on peaceful pink - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
6. A891.A - Paradise parrots on island green - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
7. A890.B - Paradise fruit on sea breeze - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. A889.A - Tropical trees on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. A888.C - Paradise pineapple on lychee - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
10. A888.B - Paradise pineapple on light lagoon - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd
11. TT27.A - White on white tiny leaves - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut - for block 1

8 x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - from bottom left to top right

From fabric 2 cut

56 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - for block 1

From each of the fabrics 3 & 4 cut

8 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - for block 1

From fabric 5 cut - for block 2

8 x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - from top left to bottom right

From fabric 6 cut

56 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once - for block 2

From each of the fabrics 7 & 8 cut

8 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - for block 2

From fabric 9 cut

8 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " W x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " H - sashing strips

8 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " H x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " W - sashing strips

15 x 3½" x 3½" - sashing

From fabric 10 cut

12 x 3½" H x 6½" W - sashing strips

12 x 3½" W x 6½" H - sashing strips

10 x 3½" x 3½" - sashing

From fabric 11 cut

40 x 3½" x 6½" - sashing strips

16 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice - for both blocks

32 x 3⅜" x 3⅜" - for both blocks

32 x 2⅞" x 2⅞" cut in half diagonally once - for both blocks

Making up the blocks

Both blocks are made up in the same way. Block 2 will be a mirror image of block 1



Block 1



Block 2

Block 2 will be made up in the same way but placement will be a mirror image of block 1.

Each of the blocks are made up in four quarters.



Top left quarter



Top right quarter



Bottom left quarter



Bottom right quarter

Start with the top left quarter. Sew the two small triangles together. Numbers 1 and 2. Stitch to number 3 square and then add number 4. Next sew the two triangles together to make a square. You will do the same to the bottom right quarter. Now the top right part of the block.

Make up the Flying Geese blocks by sewing the small triangles to each side of the larger triangle. Stitch one of the Flying Geese blocks to the large square. Next add a small square to the other Flying Geese block and stitch to the part block. Do the same to the bottom left part of the block.

Sew in rows and then the rows together to complete the block.

8 in total of block 1

Block 2 will be made up in the same way but placement will be a mirror image of block 1. 8 blocks in total.

Sashing strips.



Look at the placement of colours for each strip. Sew number 1 to number 2 to together to have a 3½" x 12½" strip.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows, pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. This will help when sewing the rows together.

Stitch your rows together to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

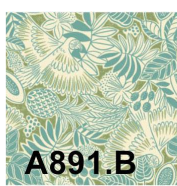
Maybe flowers. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

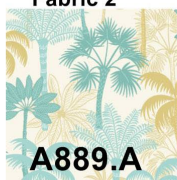

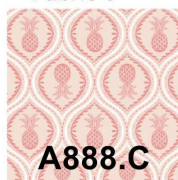

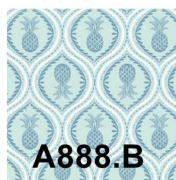
