Fabrics from Puffin Bay collection

Requirements

1. A893.A - Puffin rock lighthouse on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
2. A893.C - Puffin rock lighthouse on dark blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A894.A - Light blue waves - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. A894.C - Dark blue waves - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. A895.B - Puffin Bay puffins on light rock - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A895.C - Puffin Bay puffins on dark blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. A896.B - Orange starfish on cream - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
8. A896.C - Aqua starfish on sea green - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
9. A897.A - Seal bubbles on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
10. A897.C - Seal bubbles on dark blue - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
11. D8 - Island blue dreams - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{4}$ m

Wadding and backing 66" x 66"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

8 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " - for block 1B

From fabric 2 cut

5 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " - for block 1A

From fabric 3 cut

20 x $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{8}$ " - cut as in diagram A - for block 1A

20 x $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{5}{8}$ " - cut as in diagram B - for block 1A

From fabric 4 cut

32 x $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{8}$ " - cut as in diagram A - for block 1B

32 x $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{5}{8}$ " - cut as in diagram B - for block 1B

From fabric 5 cut

32 x 3½" x 3½" - for block 1B

From fabric 6 cut

20 x 3½" x 3½" - for block 1A

From fabric 7

32 x 2½" x 8½" – for block 2A

From fabric 8 cut

16 x 2½" x 8½" – for block 2B

From fabric 9

4 x 4½" x 4½" - for block 2B

32 x 2½" x 2½" - for block 2B

From fabric 10 cut

8 x 4½" x 4½" - for block 2A

64 x 2½" x 2½" - for block 2A

From fabric 11 cut

52 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once - for blocks 1A & 1B

13 x 3¼" x 3¼" cut in half diagonally twice - for blocks 1A & 1B

48 x 2½" x 4½" - for blocks 2A & 2B

Making up the blocks

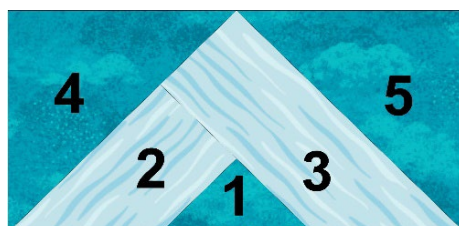

Both blocks are made up in the same way.



Part of block.

Part of block. Lay out the fabric piece for the block. Sewing by numbers. Stitch number 2 piece to the number 1, press back. Next sew number 3 to the work. Add the last two triangle to your work. Do the same to all four-part block pieces. Layout as in block diagram and sew in rows. Next stitch your rows together to complete the block. 5 in total for block 1A and 8 in total for block 1B. You need four for each block. Lay out the fabric pieces for the block. Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the block. 5 of block 1A and 8 of block 1B.

Blocks 2

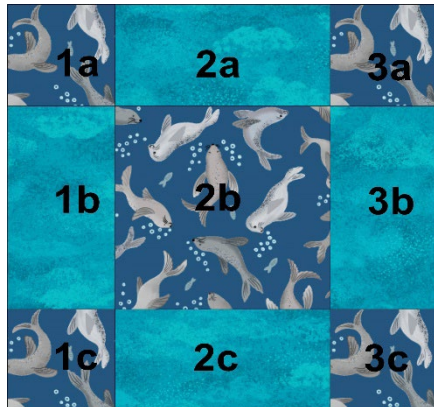

2B. Lay out the

2A block center. Sew the down in rows 1a, 1b and 1c together. Do the same to the other rows and then join them together.

Add the side strips to the part block. Now stitch a square to each end of the last two strips. Sew to complete the block. You need 4 of block 2A and 8 of block 2B.

Making up the quilt.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows, pressing the seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing your rows together.



Now sew the rows together to complete the quilt.

Quilting and binding

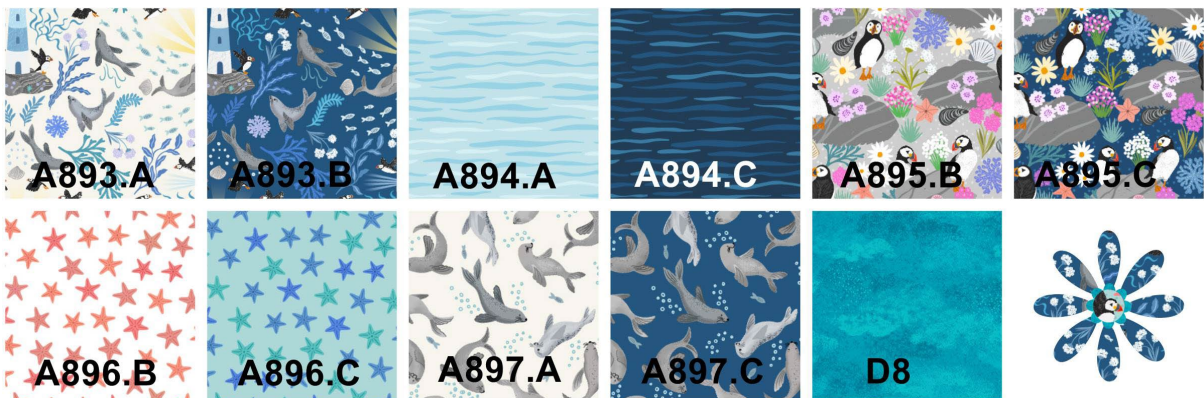
Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Maybe flowers. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 7 for binding the quilt.

2. A893.C - Puffin rock lighthouse on dark blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A894.B - Mid blue waves - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. A894.C - Dark blue waves - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. A895.C - Puffin Bay puffins on dark blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A895.A - Puffin Bay puffins on sea blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. A896.C - Aqua starfish on sea green - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
8. A896.A - Blue starfish on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
9. A897.B - Seal bubbles on light blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
10. A897.A - Seal bubbles on cream - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
11. D13 - Lilac dreams - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{4}$ m

Wadding and backing 66" x 66"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

From fabric 1 cut

8 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " - for block 1B

From fabric 2 cut

5 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " - for block 1A

From fabric 3 cut

20 x $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{8}$ " - cut as in diagram A - for block 1A

20 x $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{5}{8}$ " - cut as in diagram B - for block 1A

From fabric 4 cut

32 x $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{8}$ " - cut as in diagram A - for block 1B

32 x $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{5}{8}$ " - cut as in diagram B - for block 1B

From fabric 5 cut

32 x 3½" x 3½" - for block 1B

From fabric 6 cut

20 x 3½" x 3½" - for block 1A

From fabric 7

32 x 2½" x 8½" – for block 2A

From fabric 8 cut

16 x 2½" x 8½" – for block 2B

From fabric 9

4 x 4½" x 4½" - for block 2B

32 x 2½" x 2½" - for block 2B

From fabric 10 cut

8 x 4½" x 4½" - for block 2A

64 x 2½" x 2½" - for block 2A

From fabric 11 cut

52 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once - for blocks 1A & 1B

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48 x 2½" x 4½" - for blocks 2A & 2B

Making up the blocks

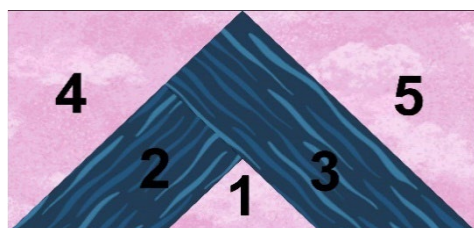

Both blocks are made up in the same way.



Part of block.

Part of block. Lay out the fabric piece for the block. Sewing by numbers. Stitch number 2 piece to the number 1, press back. Next sew number 3 to the work. Add the last two triangle to your work. Do the same to all four-part block pieces. Layout as in block diagram and sew in rows. Next stitch your rows together to complete the block. 5 in total for block 1A and 8 in total for block 1B. You need four for each block. Lay out the fabric pieces for the block. Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the block. 5 of block 1A and 8 of block 1B.

Blocks 2

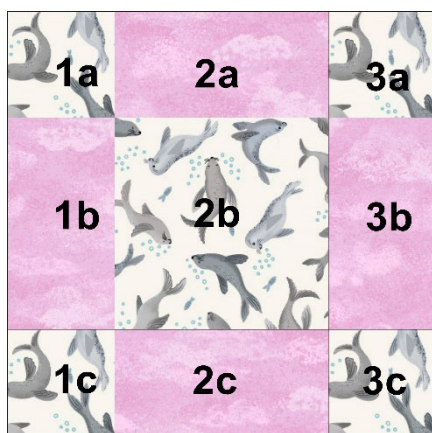

2A block center. Sew the down in rows 1a, 1b and 1c together. Do the same to the other rows and then join them together.

Add the side strips to the part block. Now stitch a square to each end of the last two strips. Sew to complete the block. You need 4 of block 2A and 8 of block 2B.

Making up the quilt.

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Now sew the rows together to complete the quilt.

Quilting and binding

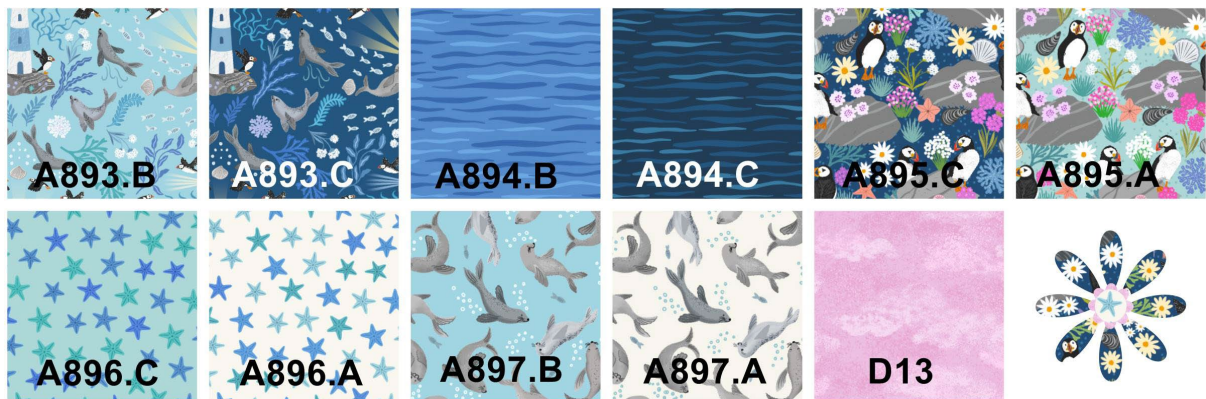
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Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.
