## Requirements

- 1. A906 Creative Landscapes mountains 1 Panel
- 2. A908A Creative landscapes flowers on cream 1/8 yd 80cm
- 3. A909B Leaf texture turquoise fat 1/4
- 4. A910C Dotty flowers on black fat 1/4
- 5. A911B Two tone floral on heather fat 1/4
- 6. A912C Creative textures blues and greens fat 1/4
- 7. A911C Two tone floral on orange ½yd ½m
- 8. BB01 White 11/4yd 1m

Wadding and backing 65" x 65"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

## Cutting

### From fabric 1 cut

Trim the panel to 351/2" x 351/2"

### From fabric 2 cut

2 x 3½" x 58½" border 6 top & bottom

2 x 31/2" x 521/2" border 6 sides

8 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once (corners)

# From each of the fabrics 3 to 6 you need to cu

16 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once (for blocks)

### From fabric 7 cut

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $52\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 5 top and bottom

2 x 11/2" x 501/2" for border 5 sides

2 x 11/2" x 401/2" for border 3 top & bottom

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $38\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 3 sides

 $2~x1\frac{1}{2}$  "  $x~37\frac{1}{2}$  " for border 1 top & bottom

2 x 11/2" x 351/2" for border 1 sides

72 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once for blocks

### From fabric 8 cut

 $2 \times 1$ " x  $38\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 2 top & bottom

 $2 \times 1'' \times 37\frac{1}{2}''$  for border 2 sides

### **Blocks**



**Block diagram** 

**Block divided into four** 

All the blocks are made in the same way.

Lay out the fabric for the block as in the main diagram. Sew each of the two small triangles together to make a square.

Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to make the square.

For each colour way you need 4 in total.

# Making up the quilt

Sew fabric 7 strip  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $35\frac{1}{2}$ " to the sides of the quilt. Next strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $37\frac{1}{2}$ " to the top and bottom.

Do the same to the next two borders (2 & 3)

### Block border 4

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. For the sides stitch 8 block together. Sew to the sides. On the top and bottom add a block to each end and sew to the quilt.

### Borders 5 and 6

Stitch border 5 to the quilt as in 1 to 3 and then do the same for border 6 to complete the quilt.

# **Quilting and binding**


Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method from fabric 7 for binding the quilt.

Wadding and backing 65" x 65"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

# Cutting

### From fabric 1 cut

Trim the panel to 35½" x 35½"

### From fabric 2 cut

2 x 31/2" x 581/2" border 6 top & bottom

2 x 3½" x 52½" border 6 sides

8 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once (corners)

# From each of the fabrics 3 to 6 you need to cu

16 x 3¾" x 3¾" cut in half diagonally once (for blocks)

### From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1½" x 52½" for border 5 top and bottom

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50½" for border 5 sides

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 3 top & bottom

2 x 11/2" x 381/2" for border 3 sides

2 x11/2" x 371/2" for border 1 top & bottom

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $35\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 1 sides

72 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once for blocks

## From fabric 8 cut

 $2 \times 1$ " x  $38\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 2 top & bottom

 $2 \times 1'' \times 37\frac{1}{2}''$  for border 2 sides

## **Blocks**

**Block divided into four** 

All the blocks are made in the same way.

Lay out the fabric for the block as in the main diagram. Sew each of the two small triangles together to make a square.

Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to make the square.

For each colour way you need 4 in total.

# Making up the quilt

Sew fabric 7 strip  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $35\frac{1}{2}$ " to the sides of the quilt. Next strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $37\frac{1}{2}$ " to the top and bottom.

Do the same to the next two borders (2 & 3)

### Block border 4

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. For the sides stitch 8 block together. Sew to the sides. On the top and bottom add a block to each end and sew to the guilt.

#### Borders 5 and 6

Stitch border 5 to the quilt as in 1 to 3 and then do the same for border 6 to complete the quilt.

# **Quilting and binding**



## From fabric 1 cut

Trim the panel to 351/2" x 351/2"

### From fabric 2 cut

2 x 31/2" x 581/2" border 6 top & bottom

2 x 31/2" x 521/2" border 6 sides

8 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once (corners)

# From each of the fabrics 3 to 6 you need to cu

16 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once (for blocks)

## From fabric 7 cut

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $52\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 5 top and bottom

2 x 11/2" x 501/2" for border 5 sides

2 x 11/2" x 401/2" for border 3 top & bottom

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $38\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 3 sides

 $2~x1\frac{1}{2}"~x~37\frac{1}{2}"$  for border 1 top & bottom

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $35\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 1 sides

72 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once for blocks

### From fabric 8 cut

 $2 \times 1$ " x  $38\frac{1}{2}$ " for border 2 top & bottom

 $2 \times 1'' \times 37\frac{1}{2}''$  for border 2 sides


