Fabrics from Witchy Woods collection

Requirements

1. A882.A - Witchy woods on Halloween orange - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{4}$ m
2. A883.B - Terrifying ticking stripe on spooky purple - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A884B - Floral cobwebs on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A885C - Spooky friends on black - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A886B - Witches hats on Halloween orange - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. BB03 - Light grey - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ m
7. BB030 - Black - $\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 80cm
8. BB027 - Royal purple - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and backing 58" x 58"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

2 x 2" x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border

2 x 2" x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides border

13 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

156 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 you need to cut

12 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2

From fabric 6 cut

52 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

52 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border top & bottom

2 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

12 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2

24 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2

52 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From fabric 8 cut

96 x 2½" x 2½" - block 2

Making up the blocks



Block 1. Lay out the fabric pieces as in the diagram. Stitch the sides strips of fabric 6 to the center square, Next sew a small square to each end of the fabric strip and stitch to your work. Keep working out in the same way until all the pieces are stitch to complete the block. You need 13 blocks in total.



Block 2.



Draw a diagonal line on the back of fabric 7. Stitch on the pencil line and trim a ¼" on the outer edge of the stitch line. Now do the same to the

other corner as in the diagrams. Do the same to three corners, but look to see which corners you need to place your squares.

You now need to sew a narrow strip in between the two squares. Top and bottom pieces. Next stitch to the center strip top and bottom to complete the quilt. You need 12 blocks in total.

Making up the quilt.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram, Stitch the rows together, pressing the seams in the opposite way each time. This will help when sewing the rows together. Stitch the rows together to complete the quilt center.

Borders

Sew the sides strips of fabric 7 to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

Now add the outer border of fabric 1 as before sides and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Maybe flowers. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 1 for binding the quilt.

Wadding and backing 58" x 58"

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

2 x 2" x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border

2 x 2" x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides border

13 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

156 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 you need to cut

12 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2

From fabric 6 cut

52 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

52 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border top & bottom

2 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

12 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2

24 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2

52 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

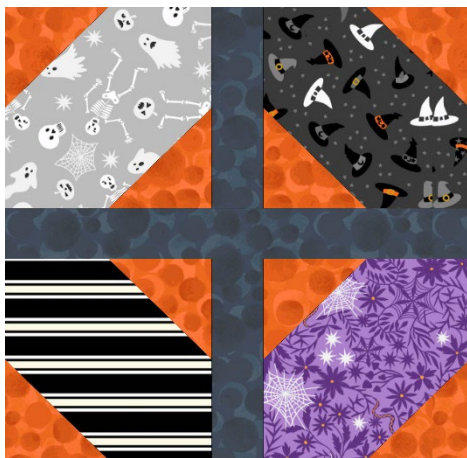
From fabric 8 cut

96 x 2½" x 2½" - block 2

Making up the blocks



Block 1. Lay out the fabric pieces as in the diagram. Stitch the sides strips of fabric 6 to the center square, Next sew a small square to each end of the fabric strip and stitch to your work. 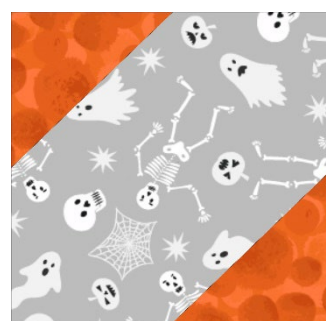

4. A885B - Spooky friends on purple - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A886A - Witches hats on ghostly grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. BB020 - Brazilian orange - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ m
7. BB030 - Black - $\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 80cm
8. BB03 - Light grey - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and backing 58" x 58"

From fabric 1 cut

2 x 2" x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border

2 x 2" x $47\frac{1}{2}$ " sides border

13 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

156 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 you need to cut

12 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2

From fabric 6 cut

52 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

52 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From fabric 7 cut

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $47\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border top & bottom

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $45\frac{1}{2}$ "

12 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2

24 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 2

52 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " - block 1

From fabric 8 cut

96 x 2½" x 2½" - block 2

Making up the blocks
