## **Fabrics from A Celtic Summer collection**

### Requirements

1. A993 Panel - (4 cushions)
2. A987B - Summer meadow Highland on breezy blue -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ m
3. A988C - Bee thistle on sage green -  $\frac{1}{4}$ yd – 30cm
4. A989A - Mirrored thistle and bee on cream -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. A990C - Celtic thistle heather -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd – 75cm
6. A991A -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
7. A992A -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
8. BB01 -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 65cm

Wadding and backing 60" x 60"

**All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.**

### **Cutting**

On some of the cutting you will see a W this is for the width and H is for the height. This is so your patterns will not be going the wrong way.

#### **From fabric 1 cut**

4 x  $17\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $17\frac{1}{2}$ " ( 4 x square panel)

#### **From fabric 2 cut**

6 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "H x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "W

6 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "W x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "H

5 x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

#### **From fabric 3 cut**

12 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

#### **From fabric 4 cut**

6 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "H x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "W

6 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "W x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "H

#### **From fabric 5 cut**

36 x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

120 x 1" x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

#### **From fabric 6 cut**

6 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "H x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "W



6 x 3½"W x 4½"H

**From fabric 7 cut**

12 x 3½" x 4½"

**From fabric 8 cut**

8 x 2" x 20½" top & bottom

8 x 2" x 17½" sides

### Making up the throw



Sew a strip to each side of the cushion plane, press back. Stitch a strip to the top & bottom to complete this part. Do the same to the other three panels.



Look at the main diagram for the lay out of the fabric pieces. Sew a strip to each side of the fabric 3½" x 4½".



**Diamond in a square.** Stitch the opposite triangles to the square. Fold in half on each piece and match the folds pin into place. Sew and do the same to the other two triangles to complete the block. You need 8 blocks in total. 5 in one colour way and four in the other colour way.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows.



Start with the top row and then the next row will be blocks and panels in between. Work down the rows and then sew your rows together to complete the quilt centre.

### **Quilting and binding**

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

## Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 5 for binding the quilt.
