

Fabrics from Small Things...Fairytale collection

Requirements

1. SM115 - Three Bears - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
2. SM116 - Mermaid - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. SM117 - Piggies - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. SM118 - Snow White - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. SM119 - Jack and the Beanstalk - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. SM120 - Oz - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. SM121 - Wonderland - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. SM122 - Aladdin - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. SM123 - Cinderella - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. SM124 - Ugly Duckling - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. SM125 - Rapunzel - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
12. SM126 - Hansel and Gretel - $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{4}$ m
13. SM127 - Puss in Boots - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
14. SM128 - Red Riding Hood - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
15. SM129 - Fairytale - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
16. BB01 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and backing 60" x 60

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1, 5, 7, 9, 11 and 13 you need to cut

4 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 10, 14 and 15 you need to cut

3 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 12 cut

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom

2 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 x 1½ x 1½"

From fabric 16 cut

4 x 1½" x 42½"

8 x 1½" x 3½"

98 x 1½" x 98½"

Making up the quilt




Look at the fabric lay out from the main diagram.

You will stitch a strip to each side of your 4½" x 6½" fabric piece.

On some it will be top and bottom. The other half it will be on the sides.

When you have sewn all the blocks lay out as in the main diagram and sew in rows. Pressing the seam in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing your rows together.

Stitch the rows together to complete the quilt centre.



Border

Inner border

Stitch a strip of fabric 16 1/2" x 42 1/2" to the sides, press. On the other two strips add a square fabric 12 to each end of the strips and sew to the quilt.

Middle border

Lay out all the squares as in the main diagram. Stitch the squares together for the sides you will add a narrow strip to each end. Sew to the quilt, press. On the top and bottom you will add the strips and a square to each end. Sew this to the quilt, press.

Outer border

Sew the sides and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt.



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
