Size of quilt 54" x 54" - unfinished block sizes 8½" x 8½" & 4½" x 4½"



Main Diagram

Fabrics from Boho Blooms collection

Requirements

1. L17B - Little daisies pink on navy - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
2. L14A - Turquoise and blue flower sprigs - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
3. L15B - Floral burst aqua and blue - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
4. L16D - Boho blooms blues and pinks on navy - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
5. L14C - Sunshine yellow flower sprigs - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
6. L18B - Blue flower circles - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
7. L17C - Little daisies red on pink - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
8. L16B - Boho blooms pretty purples - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
9. L16F - Boho blooms on summer red - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
10. L13 - Boho Blooms Ombre - 1yd - 1m (including $\frac{1}{2}$ yd for binding)
11. BB01 – Bumbleberries White - $2\frac{1}{3}$ yd - $2\frac{1}{3}$ m

Wadding and backing 60" x 60"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

1 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (hearts)

1 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 2 cut

1 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (hearts)

1 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

1 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 2 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

2 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 3 cut

1 x 6½" x WOF

Sub cut: 8 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

From fabric 4 cut

1 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 6 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 5 cut

1 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 6 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)



From fabric 6 cut

1 x 6½" x WOF

Sub cut: 8 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass Border)

From fabric 7 cut

1 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 2 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 8 cut

1 x 6½" x WOF

Sub cut: 8 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 9 cut

1 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

1 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 2 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

2 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 10 cut

5 x 2½" x WOF

Make: 2 x 2½" x 50½" strips (side borders)

2 x 2½" x 54½" strips (top & bottom borders)

From fabric 11 cut

1 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 8 x 1½" x 4½" rectangles (hourglass spacers border)

3 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 22 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice) (hourglass border)

1 x 8½" x WOF

Sub cut: 24 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

1 x 6½" x WOF

Sub cut: 24 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

5 x 1¾" x WOF

Sub cut: 100 x 1¾" x 1¾" squares (heart blocks)

5 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 50 x 3½" x 3½" squares (heart blocks)

4 x 1½" x WOF

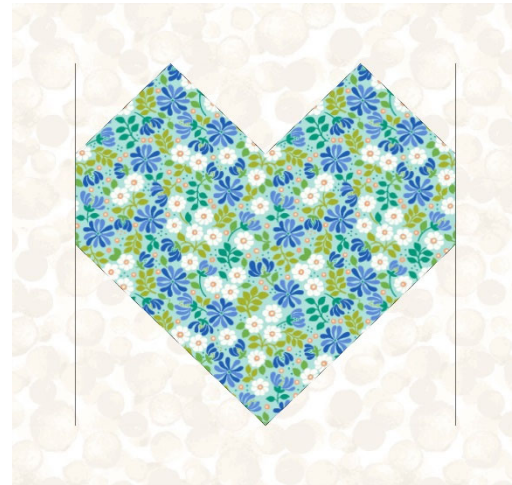
Make: 2 x 1½" x 40½" strips (inner side borders)

2 x 1½" x 42½" strips (inner top and bottom borders)

Making up the blocks



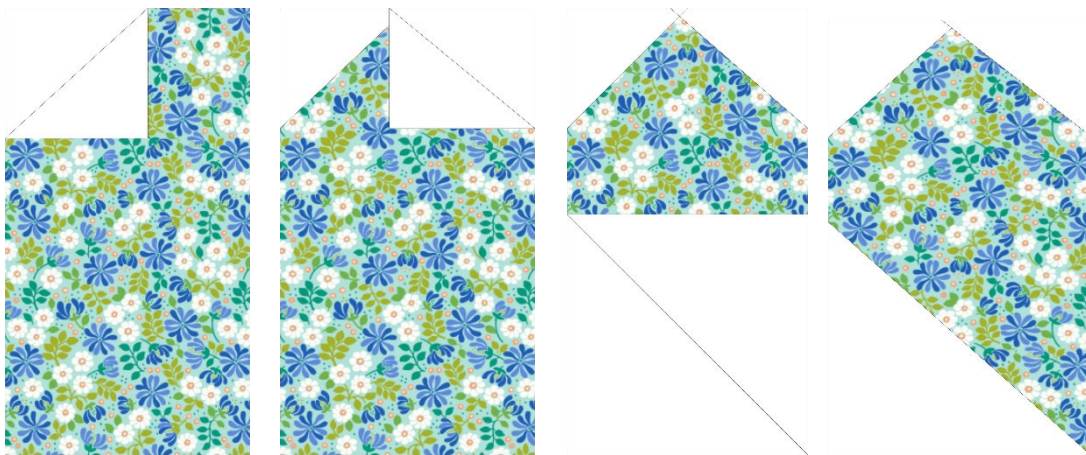
Block 1



Block 2

Both of the blocks are made up in the same way. Making up the heart.

On the back background fabrics $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " draw a diagonal line.



Place a small square on the top left side and sew just on the outer edge of the pencil line. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam from the pencil line on the outer edge, press. Do the same to the other corner. Next the bottom corner as before. (You can make a small square from the left-over pieces of this part). Do the same to the other side, but this time on the right side on the bottom corner. Join the two halves to complete the heart. On block 1 stitch the pattern fabric strips. Sides and then top and bottom. Block 2 this will be the background fabric.

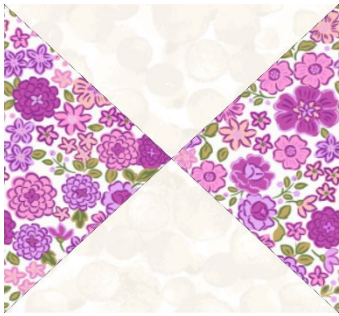
Making up the quilt center

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sewing in rows and then the rows together to complete the center.

Inner border

Stitch the sides, press and then top and bottom to the quilt.

Middle border



All blocks made in the same way. Sew two small triangles together and then stitch them together to make the block. Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. On sides you add a strip of fabric 11 to each end and sew to quilt. Do the same to the top and bottom strips, but this time add a square as well to each end. Sew to the quilt.

Outer border

Stitch the sides to the quilt and then top and bottom to complete the quilt.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 10 for binding the quilt.

Fabrics from Boho Blooms collection

Requirements

1. L16A - Boho blooms pinks and peaches - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
2. L18C - Yellow and blue flower circles - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
3. L15C - Floral burst on dark purple - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
4. L16E - Boho Blooms on yellow - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
5. L17A - Little daisies cream on aqua - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
6. L15A - Floral burst pinks and green - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
7. L16C - Boho blooms terrific turquoise - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
8. L14B - Bright pink flower sprigs - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
9. L18A - Red flower circles - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
10. L13 - Boho Blooms Ombre - 1yd - 1m (include $\frac{1}{2}$ yd for binding)
11. BB01 – Bumbleberries White - $2\frac{1}{3}$ yd - $2\frac{1}{3}$ m

Wadding and backing 60" x 60"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

1 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (hearts)

1 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 2 cut

1 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (hearts)

1 x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

1 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 2 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

2 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 3 cut

1 x 6½" x WOF

Sub cut: 8 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

From fabric 4 cut

1 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 6 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 5 cut

1 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 6 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)



From fabric 6 cut

1 x 6½" x WOF

Sub cut: 8 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass Border)

From fabric 7 cut

1 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 2 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 8 cut

1 x 6½" x WOF

Sub cut: 8 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

2 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

4 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 9 cut

1 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 4 x 3½" x 6½" rectangles (hearts)

1 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 3 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice)
(hourglass border)

1 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 2 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

2 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

From fabric 10 cut

5 x 2½" x WOF

Make: 2 x 2½" x 50½" strips (side borders)

2 x 2½" x 54½" strips (top & bottom borders)

From fabric 11 cut

1 x 1½" x WOF

Sub cut: 8 x 1½" x 4½" rectangles (hourglass spacers border)

3 x 5½" x WOF

Sub cut: 22 x 5½" x 5½" squares (cut each square diagonally twice) (hourglass border)

1 x 8½" x WOF

Sub cut: 24 x 1½" x 8½" rectangles (heart block borders)

1 x 6½" x WOF

Sub cut: 24 x 1½" x 6½" rectangles (heart block borders)

5 x 1¾" x WOF

Sub cut: 100 x 1¾" x 1¾" squares (heart blocks)

5 x 3½" x WOF

Sub cut: 50 x 3½" x 3½" squares (heart blocks)

4 x 1½" x WOF

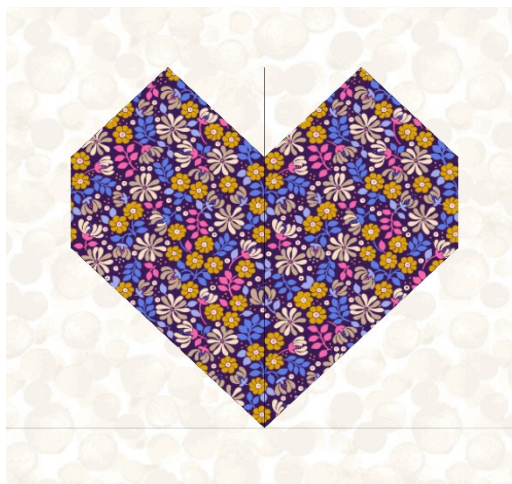
Make: 2 x 1½" x 40½" strips (inner side borders)

2 x 1½" x 42½" strips (inner top and bottom borders)

Making up the blocks



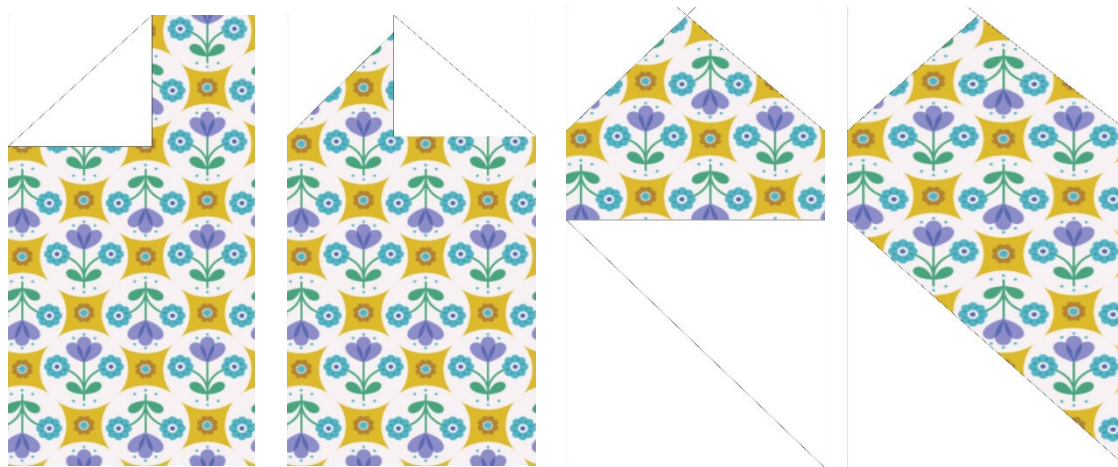
Block 1



Block 2

Both of the blocks are made up in the same way. Making up the heart.

On the back background fabrics $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " draw a diagonal line.



Place a small square on the top left side and sew just on the outer edge of the pencil line. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam from the pencil line on the outer edge, press. Do the same to the other corner. Next the bottom corner as before. (You can make a small square from the left-over pieces of this part). Do the same to the other side, but this time on the right side on the bottom corner. Join the two halves to complete the heart. On block 1 stitch the pattern fabric strips. Sides and then top and bottom. Block 2 this will be the background fabric.

Making up the quilt center

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sewing in rows and then the rows together to complete the center.

Inner border

Stitch the sides, press and then top and bottom to the quilt.

Middle border



All blocks made in the same way. Sew two small triangles together and then stitch them together to make the block. Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. On sides you add a strip of fabric 11 to each end and sew to quilt. Do the same to the top and bottom strips, but this time add a square as well to each end. Sew to the quilt.

Outer border

Stitch the sides to the quilt and then top and bottom to complete the quilt.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 10 for binding the quilt.
