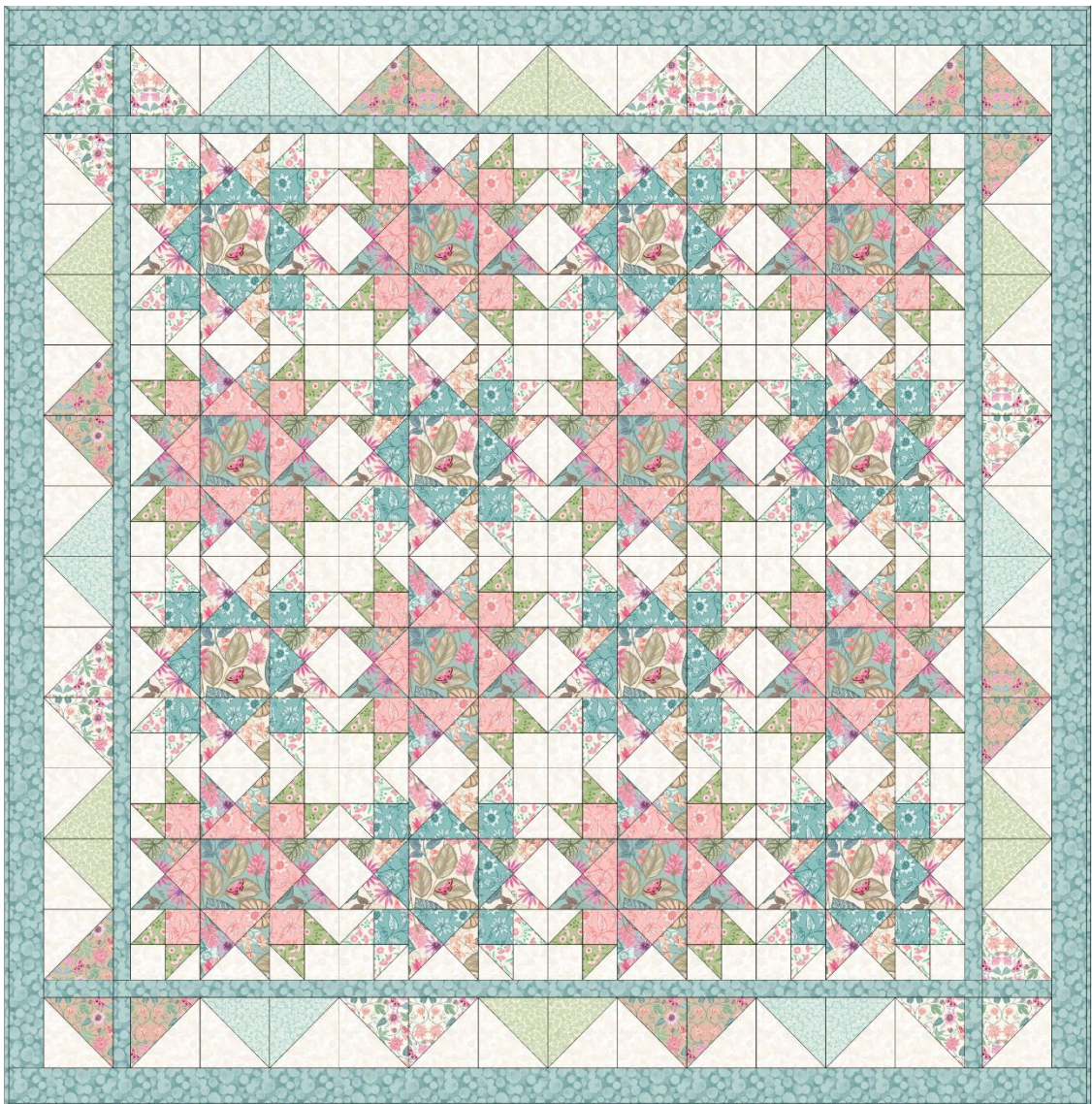




Designed and made by Sally Ablett – Quilt 1

Size 62" x 62" - unfinished block size 12½" x 12½" - 4½" x 4½"



Main Diagram

Fabrics from Botanical Oasis collection

Requirements

1. A982A - Botanical flora on cream - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
2. A983B - Mini leaves on blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A984A - Tropical flower on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A985A - Botanical butterfly on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A986B - Passion flower on pink - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A982C - Botanical flora on oasis blue - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
7. A983C - Mini leaves on light cocoa - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. A984C - Tropical flower on green - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. A985C - Botanical butterfly on natural - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. A986C - Passion flower on blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
11. BB01 - White - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m
12. BB033 - Duck egg - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1 & 6 you need to cut

16 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

8 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 2 & 7 you need to cut

6 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 3 & 8 you need to cut

32 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 4 & 9 you need to cut

7 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 5 & 10 you need to cut

8 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

32 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 11 cut

16 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice

26 x 4⅞" x 4⅞" cut in half diagonally once

32 x 2⅞" x 2⅞" cut in half diagonally once

64 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 12 cut (you need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips)

2 x 2½" x 62½" top & bottom (outer border)

2 x 2½" x 58½" sides (outer border)

2 x 1½" x 50½" top & bottom (inner border)

2 x 1½" x 48½" sides inner (border)

8 x 1½" x 4½" (corner sashing pieces)



Block 1



Block 2

Both blocks are made up in the same. Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1. Start with the corner pieces. Sew the triangles together to make a square and then stitch in rows. Next stitch your rows together to complete the block. Do all four corners

Middle sets

Sew two small triangles together and then stitch both triangles together to complete the square.

Lay out all the pieces and sew in rows and then stitch all the rows together to complete the block. 8 in total of block 1.

Block 2 is stitch in the same way.

Again 8 in total for block 2.

Making up the middle border blocks



Lay out your fabric pieces. You will have one pattern and a background fabric. Stitch the two triangles together to make a square. Fabrics 3 and 8 you need seven sets. For fabrics 4 and 9 you will have six sets.

Making up the quilt

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows and if you press your seams in the opposite way each time this will help when sewing the rows together.



Inner border

Sew the sides to the quilt, press.

Next the top and bottom to the quilt.

Middle border

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. 12 blocks for each strip with a strip at each end of fabric 12.

Sew the sides to the quilt, press.

On the top and bottom you will add the strips and a block to each end. Stitch this the quilt.

Outer border

Take the side strips of fabric 12 sew to quilt and top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method for binding the quilt.

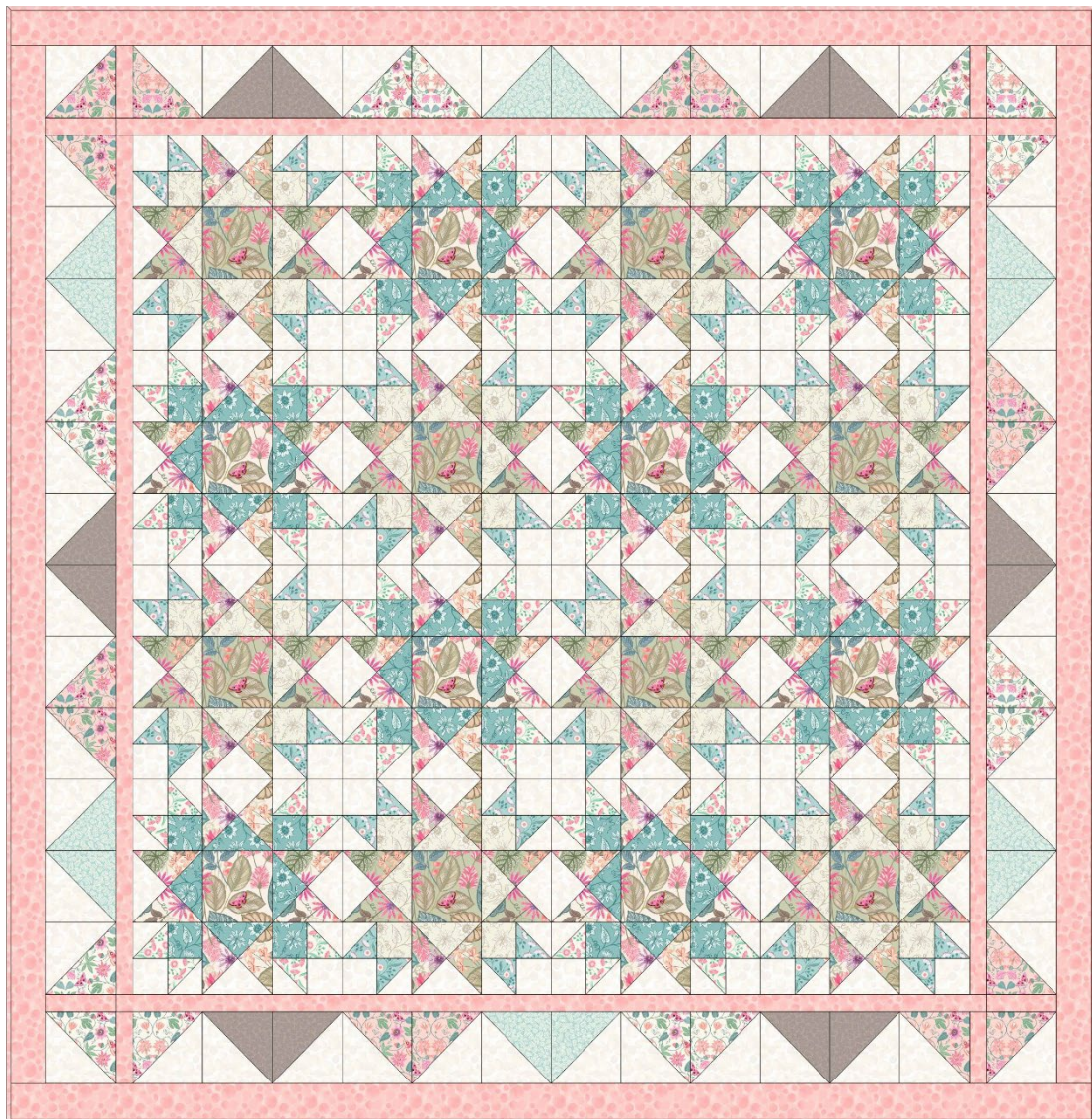

1. A982B - Botanical flora on soft sage - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
2. A983C - Mini leaves on light cocoa - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A984B - Tropical flower on blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A985B - Botanical butterfly on pink - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A986A - Passion flower on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A982A - Botanical flora on cream - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
7. A983B - Mini leaves on blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. A984A - Tropical flower on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
9. A985A - Botanical butterfly on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. A986C - Passion flower on blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
11. BB01 - White - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m
12. BB06 - Light pink - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $1\frac{1}{2}$ m

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1 & 6 you need to cut

16 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

8 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each of the fabrics 2 & 7 you need to cut

6 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 3 & 8 you need to cut

32 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 4 & 9 you need to cut

7 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From each of the fabrics 5 & 10 you need to cut

8 x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

32 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 11 cut

16 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice

26 x 4⅞" x 4⅞" cut in half diagonally once

32 x 2⅞" x 2⅞" cut in half diagonally once

64 x 2½" x 2½"

From fabric 12 cut (you need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips)

2 x 2½" x 62½" top & bottom (outer border)

2 x 2½" x 58½" sides (outer border)

2 x 1½" x 50½" top & bottom (inner border)

2 x 1½" x 48½" sides inner (border)

8 x 1½" x 4½" (corner sashing pieces)



Block 1



Block 2

Middle sets

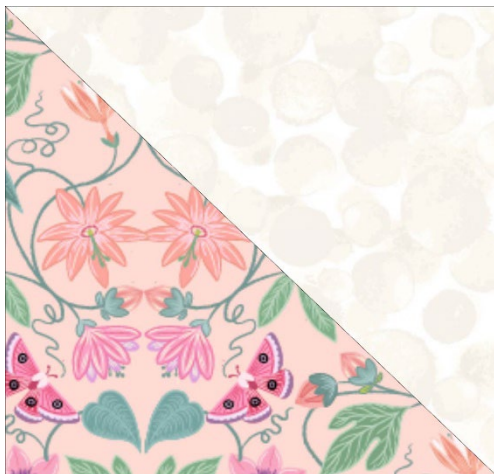
