Main Diagram

Fabrics from Transylvania Glow collection

Requirements

1. L7A - Beware the werewolves - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
2. L8A - Scattered scaredy cats - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. L9C - Stars on black - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. L10B - Bat ombre purple - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. L7B - Dracula's bed - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. L8B - Scattered jack o lanterns - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
7. L9A - Stars on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
8. L10A - Bat ombre orange - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
9. A883A - Terrifying ticking stripe on Halloween orange - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
10. A883B - Terrifying ticking stripe on spooky purple - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
11. BB328 - Glow in the dark - 2yd - 2m
12. BB030 - Black - fat $\frac{1}{4}$

Wadding and backing - 64" x 70"

Binding – 1/2yd

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 and 5 cut

1 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 8 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (cut diagonally once)

1 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 5 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From fabric 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 & 8 cut

1 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 8 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (cut diagonally once)

1 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 3 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From fabric 9 & 10 cut

4 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 8 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Cut 4 diagonally once from top left to bottom right

Cut 4 diagonally once from bottom left to top right
1 x 4½" x WOF
Subcut: 3 x 4½" x 4½" squares

From fabric 11 cut

1 x 1½" x WOF
Sub cut: 8 x 1½" X 4½" rectangles (border spacers)
2 x 4⅞" x WOF
Sub cut 11 x 4⅞" x 4⅞" squares (cut diagonally once)
5 x 4½" x WOF
Sub cut 42 x 4½" x 4½" squares
4 x 2⅞" x WOF
Sub cut 48 x 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares (cut diagonally ONCE)
5 x 1½" x WOF
Make 2 x 1½" X 46½" (inner top & bottom borders)
2 x 1½" X 52½" (inner side borders)
6 x 1½" x WOF
Make 2 x 1½" X 56½" (outer top & bottom borders)
2 – 1½" X 62½" (outer side borders)

From fabric 12 cut

4 x 3⅜" x 21" strip
Subcut: 24 x 3⅜" x 3⅜" squares

Making up the blocks

Lay out fabric pieces for the quilt as in the main diagram. I would work on a row at a time and sew the row together as you work. This will help not to make mistakes.



Quilt block

Sew the two triangles together to make a square. Work along the row and stitch this row together adding the plain squares in between. Keep

working down the quilt. When you have stitch all the blocks together check to make sure all your pieces are in the right place. Now sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

Inner border

Stitch the sides and then the top and bottom to the quilt.

Middle border



Lay out fabrics for the block. Stitch a small triangle to the opposite sides of the square, press. Do the same to the other two triangles. You need 24 in total.



Look at the lay out on the main diagram as to which fabrics you need to sew together to make a square.

Place your blocks as in the main diagram and stitch together.

On the sides add a strip to each and sew to quilt. Do the same to the top and bottom row adding a strip and square to each end. Sew to quilt and add the last border. Sides and then top and bottom to complete the quilt.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.

1. L7C - Scaredy cats - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
2. L8C - Scattered Draculas - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. L9B - Stars on orange - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. L10A - Bat ombre orange - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. L7A - Beware the werewolves - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. L8A - Scattered scaredy cats - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
7. L9C - Stars on black - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
8. L10C - Bat ombre grey to black - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
9. A883A - Terrifying ticking stripe on Halloween orange - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
10. A883C - Terrifying ticking stripe on black - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
11. BB328 - Glow in the dark - 2yd - 2m
12. BB030 - Black - fat $\frac{1}{4}$

Wadding and backing 64" x 70"

Binding - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting

From fabric 1 and 5 cut

1 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 8 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (cut diagonally once)

1 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 5 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From fabric 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 & 8 cut

1 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 8 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (cut diagonally once)

1 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 3 x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From fabric 9 & 10 cut

4 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 8 x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Cut 4 diagonally once from top left to bottom right
Cut 4 diagonally once from bottom left to top right
1 x 4½" x WOF
Subcut: 3 x 4½" x 4½" squares

From fabric 11 cut

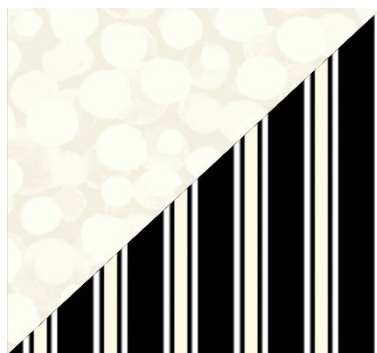
1 x 1½" x WOF
Sub cut: 8 x 1½" X 4½" rectangles (border spacers)
2 x 4⅞" x WOF
Sub cut 11 x 4⅞" x 4⅞" squares (cut diagonally once)
5 x 4½" x WOF
Sub cut 42 x 4½" x 4½" squares
4 x 2⅞" x WOF
Sub cut 48 x 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares (cut diagonally ONCE)
5 x 1½" x WOF
Make 2 x 1½" X 46½" (inner top & bottom borders)
2 x 1½" X 52½" (inner side borders)
6 x 1½" x WOF
Make 2 x 1½" X 56½" (outer top & bottom borders)
2 – 1½" X 62½" (outer side borders)

From fabric 12 cut

4 x 3⅜" x 21" strip
Subcut: 24 x 3⅜" x 3⅜" squares

Making up the blocks

Lay out fabric pieces for the quilt as in the main diagram. I would work on a row at a time and sew the row together as you work. This will help not to make mistakes.



Quilt block

Sew the two triangles together to make a square. Work along the row and stitch this row together adding the plain squares in between. Keep working down the quilt. When you have stitch all the blocks together check to make sure all your pieces are in the right place. Now sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

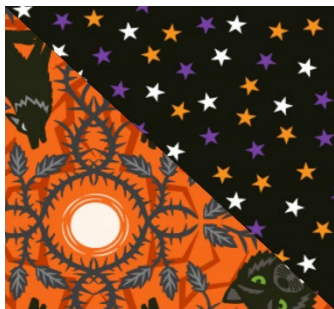
Inner border

Stitch the sides and then the top and bottom to the quilt.

Middle border



Lay out fabrics for the block. Stitch a small triangle to the opposite sides of the square, press. Do the same to the other two triangles. You need 24 in total.



Look at the lay out on the main diagram as to which fabrics you need to sew together to make a square.

Place your blocks as in the main diagram and stitch together.

On the sides add a strip to each and sew to quilt. Do the same to the top and bottom row adding a strip and square to each end. Sew to quilt and add the last border. Sides and then top and bottom to complete the quilt.

Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.
