## **Fabrics from Transylvania Glow collection**

### Requirements

1. L11 - panel
2. L7B - Dracula's bed -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ m
3. L8B - Scattered jack o lanterns -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. L9A - Stars on cream -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. L10C - Bat ombre grey to black -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A833A - Terrifying ticking stripe on Halloween orange -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
7. BB328 – Bumbleberries Glow in the dark -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
8. BB030 – Bumbleberries Black -  $\frac{1}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{4}$ m

Wadding and backing 62" x 62"

Binding -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

**All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.**

### **Cutting**

#### **From fabric 1 cut**

1 x 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (panel)

#### **From fabric 2 cut**

2 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 8 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " (cut diagonally once)

1 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 4 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (outer border corners)

#### **From fabric 3 & 4 cut**

2 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 10 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " (cut diagonally once)

#### **From fabric 5 cut**

2 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 8 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " (cut diagonally once)

#### **From fabric 6 cut**

3 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Subcut: 20 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

2 x 5½" x WOF

Subcut: 20 x 3½" x 5½" rectangles

### **From fabric 7 cut**

4 x 1½" x WOF

Make: 2 x 1½" x 35½" (first inner border sides)

2 x 1½" x 37½" (first inner border top and bottom)

4 x 1½" x WOF

Make: 2 x 1½" x 39½" (outer inner border sides)

2 x 1½" x 41½" (outer inner border top and bottom)

### **From fabric 8 cut**

4 x 1½" x WOF

Make: 2 x 1½" x 37½" (middle inner border sides)

2 x 1½" x 39½" (middle inner border top and bottom)

### **Making half square triangle squares**

Make 12 using fabrics 3 & 4.

Make 8 using fabrics 2 & 5.

Make 8 using fabrics 4 & 5.

Make 8 using fabrics 2 & 3.

### **Making up the throw**

Add side borders, from inner to outer, to the throw. Press and then add top and bottom borders.

**Border 4 – half square triangles.** Lay out all the triangle squares as in main diagram. Stitch the side squares together and sew them to the throw. Next stitch all the blocks together for the top and bottom. Add to the throw.

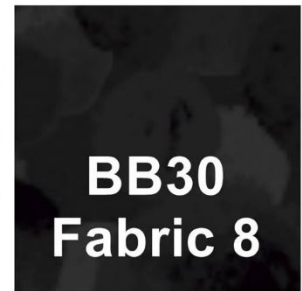
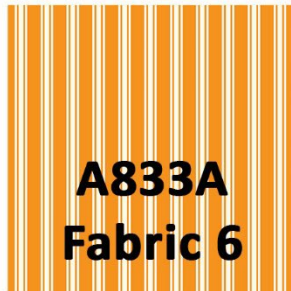
Outer border. Lay out your fabric pieces as in the main diagram. Join the side pieces together and sew to the throw. With the top and bottom add a square to each end and stitch to the throw to complete.

## Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.



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
