## **Fabrics from Christmas in Bluebell Wood collection**

### Requirements

1. C139B - Christmas in bluebell wood green -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
2. C140C - Snowdrops on Christmas green -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. C141A - Scattered festive on cream -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
4. C142B - Snowflake hedgehog on red -  $\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 90cm
5. C143A - Gold stars on cream - 1yd - 1m
6. C144B - Spruce garland on red -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ m
7. BB01 – Bumbleberries White - 1yd - 1m

Wadding and backing 55" x 55"

**All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.  
You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.**

**HST = half square triangles**

### **Cutting**

#### **From fabric 1 cut**

5 x 3½" x WOF strips

Make: 4 x 3½" x 42½" (outer border)

#### **From fabric 2 cut (HST)**

3 x 4" x WOF strips

Subcut: 26 x 4" x 4"

#### **From fabric 3 cut (HST)**

4 x 4" x WOF strips

Subcut: 36 x 4" x 4"

#### **From fabric 4 cut (HST)**

3 x 4" x WOF strips

Subcut: 28 x 4" x 4"

**From fabric 5 cut**

4 x 1½ x WOF strips

Make: 2 x 1½" x 38½" (top and bottom inner borders)

2 x 1½" x 36½" (side inner borders)

1 x 3½" x WOF strips

Subcut: 4 x 3½" x 3½"

4 x 2½" x 2½"

5 x 2½" x WOF strips (binding)

**From fabric 6 cut**

4 x 2½" x WOF strips

Make: 4 x 2½" x 38½" (sides, top and bottom borders)

**From fabric 7 cut (HST)**

6 x 4" x WOF stripes

Subcut: 54 x 4" x 4"

Make the following HST (trim each to 3½" square)

Fabrics 3 & 7 = 36

Fabrics 4 & 7 = 36

Fabrics 2 & 7 = 36

Fabrics 3 & 4 = 20

Fabrics 2 & 3 = 16

## Making up the blocks

Both blocks are made up in the same way.



**Block 1**



**Block 2**

Lay out your fabric pieces for block 1 as in diagram. Stitch two small triangles together to make a square. Next sew in rows and then stitch your rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need 5 in total.

Block 2 make up in the same. You will have 4 blocks in total.

Lay out as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows and then sew your rows together to complete the center of the throw.

### Inner border

You need fabric 5 strips for the inner border. Sew the sides to the throw, press. Add the top and bottom to complete the inner border.

### Middle border

Stitch the sides strips of fabric 4 to your work, press.

With the top and bottom strips add a square to each end. Sew to your work, press.

### Outer border

Do the same as the middle border to complete the throw.

## Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

## Binding

Use your favorite method for binding the quilt.

3. C141C - Scattered festive on green -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
4. C142A - Snowflake hedgehog on cream -  $\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 90cm
5. C143C - Gold stars on Christmas green - 1yd - 1m
6. C144A - Spruce garland on cream -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ m
7. BB03 – Bumbleberries Light grey - 1yd - 1m

Wadding and backing 55" x 55"

**All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.  
You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.**

### **Cutting**

#### **From fabric 1 cut**

5 x 3½" x WOF strips

Make: 4 x 3½" x 42½" (outer border)

#### **From fabric 2 cut (HST)**

3 x 4" x WOF strips

Subcut: 26 x 4" x 4"

#### **From fabric 3 cut (HST)**

4 x 4" x WOF strips

Subcut: 36 x 4" x 4"

#### **From fabric 4 cut (HST)**

3 x 4" x WOF strips

Subcut: 28 x 4" x 4"

#### **From fabric 5 cut**

4 x 1½ x WOF strips

Make: 2 x 1½" x 38½" (top and bottom inner borders)

2 x 1½" x 36½" (side inner borders)

1 x 3½" x WOF strips

Subcut: 4 x 3½" x 3½"

4 x 2½" x 2½"

5 x 2½" x WOF strips (binding)

**From fabric 6 cut**

4 x 2½" x WOF strips

Make: 4 x 2½" x 38½" (sides, top and bottom borders)

**From fabric 7 cut (HST)**

6 x 4" x WOF stripes

Subcut: 54 x 4" x 4"

Make the following HST (trim each to 3½" square)

Fabrics 3 & 7 = 36

Fabrics 4 & 7 = 36

Fabrics 2 & 7 = 36

Fabrics 3 & 4 = 20

Fabrics 2 & 3 = 16

## Making up the blocks

Both blocks are made up in the same way.



**Block 1**



**Block 2**

Lay out your fabric pieces for block 1 as in diagram. Stitch two small triangles together to make a square. Next sew in rows and then stitch your rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need 5 in total.

Block 2 make up in the same. You will have 4 blocks in total.

Lay out as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows and then sew your rows together to complete the center of the throw.

### Inner border

You need fabric 5 strips for the inner border. Sew the sides to the throw, press. Add the top and bottom to complete the inner border.

### Middle border

Stitch the sides strips of fabric 4 to your work, press.

With the top and bottom strips add a square to each end. Sew to your work, press.

### Outer border

Do the same as the middle border to complete the throw.

## Quilting and binding

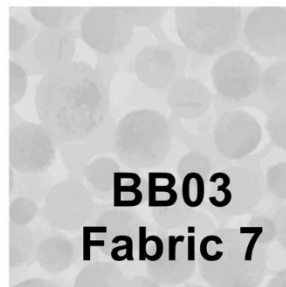
Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

1. C139C - Christmas in bluebell wood night time -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
2. C140A - Snowdrops on cream -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. C141B - Scattered festive on red -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
4. C142C - Snowflake hedgehog on night time -  $\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 90cm
5. C143B - Gold stars on red - 1yd - 1m
6. C144C - Spruce garland on Christmas green -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ m
7. BB01 – Bumbleberries White - 1yd - 1m

Wadding and backing 55" x 55"

**All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.  
You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.**

### **Cutting**

#### **From fabric 1 cut**

5 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips

Make: 4 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (outer border)

#### **From fabric 2 cut (HST)**

3 x 4" x WOF strips

Subcut: 26 x 4" x 4"

#### **From fabric 3 cut (HST)**

4 x 4" x WOF strips

Subcut: 36 x 4" x 4"

#### **From fabric 4 cut (HST)**

3 x 4" x WOF strips

Subcut: 28 x 4" x 4"

**From fabric 5 cut**

4 x 1½ x WOF strips

Make: 2 x 1½" x 38½" (top and bottom inner borders)

2 x 1½" x 36½" (side inner borders)

1 x 3½" x WOF strips

Subcut: 4 x 3½" x 3½"

4 x 2½" x 2½"

5 x 2½" x WOF strips (binding)

**From fabric 6 cut**

4 x 2½" x WOF strips

Make: 4 x 2½" x 38½" (sides, top and bottom borders)

**From fabric 7 cut (HST)**

6 x 4" x WOF stripes

Subcut: 54 x 4" x 4"

Make the following HST (trim each to 3½" square)

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Fabrics 2 & 7 = 36

Fabrics 3 & 4 = 20

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### Middle border

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With the top and bottom strips add a square to each end. Sew to your work, press.

### Outer border

Do the same as the middle border to complete the throw.

## Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine a pattern to match the quilt.

Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method for binding the quilt.
